

The first quail call was given at 5:32

The first Dove Cooring given at 6:50 and continued regularly, ~~to~~ even after completion of $3\frac{1}{4}$ hrs observation when leaving station at 7:30

7:51 Sundown

8:03 Arrived at Camp (no observations recorded except location of another extensive field below one examined earlier. About same area in extent.

8:04 Can hear the single grunt of the Dusky Grouse (?) in direction of Baldy or beyond, coming in about every 20 seconds. Heard suddenly stopping about time after sun went down

8:15 R.N. Pheasant, Spurred Towhee and mourning Dove still calling.

8:37 Moon just presenting itself over Cascades a little way to the south of the highest peak.

8:38 Heard calls coming from Baldy. All other call have stopped.

8:45 The weird call is now moving down the mountain to the west and is close enough to hear the last portion of his call.

9:00 Heard call quieted.

9:09 Starting up again but over the bunk. Heard say about 1 block west of camp. Called for about three minutes then quite.

9:45 To Bed

2nd Morning (5/13/38)

4:35 Towhee (Spurred) and Pheasant calling.

5:40 Out of bed after expenditure of considerable will power.

5:46 Hummer passing to the east calling.

6:00 Sun shine from Provo Canyon shining on edge of west side of lake about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north of Pelican Point.

6:07 Up behold! the sun shine is now crossing the state road below ^{point} between Great Pleasant Grove

6:28 Hummer flew east, calling then N.W.

6:45 Breakfast over, dishes washed and leaving for trail to Battle Creek with same objective as preceding day and same manner of recording (Complete census)

6:45 Sky clear, not one cloud in the sky, slight wind and much cooler than yesterday at same time.

6:45 Leaving camp with Virginia Warbler warbling and a Spurred Towhee singing directly below camp.

6:46 Three Virginia Warblers in chokecherry tree above spring. One chased second member through oak trees darting up & down with frequent contacts. The remaining bird feed upon insect on limbs of tree.

6:55 Virginia warbler chirping as he worked along from tree top to tree top.

6:56 Pheasant has only called 8 times since starting about 6:45

6:58 Pheasant calling & drumming

7:00 3 Towhees, 2 singing one holding 300 ft north of spring, 1 Virginia Warbler singing.

7:02 2 Virginia warblers chasing each other.
