

- 8:56 Grackle singing on east escarpment just over top.
- 9:00 Towhee singing to left, 40' on bank. Passed & he continued to sing
- 9:00 Humming bird fly west. calling
- 9:05 Two Woodhouse jays approach a oak stand calling vigorously, lit and worked up branches to top of tree & remained quiet for 1 minute then flew west with same call as used in approaching.
- 9:05 Grackle came from bank of valley & lit in oak to sing. Flew across open portion of valley to left and lit in another oak and sang, worked through middle portion of trees singing then upon ground still offering its song. It moved into Towhee territory and was immediately attacked but stayed near by
- 9:15 Spurred Towhee just starting to sing to the right, approached & he stopped.
- 9:20 Two ♂ Virginia warblers fighting with ♀ sitting unconcerned 2 feet away. The males held tail like wren. Finally one male chased the other through oaks & ♀ flew across opening to left. Males did not follow her immediately.
- 9:21 Two Towhees singing 100' apart.
- 9:21 E. d. utahensis very shy, running through oaks & could not be approached.
- 9:22 Examined good deer bedding ground under large oaks in flat portion of valley.
- 9:25 Two Spurred Towhees feeding together, one leading in activity. One remained upon the ground but occasionally the other would work up into top of oak & sing. One was quite concerned about the other and actually met at one time.
- 9:25 Spurred Towhee & Virginia warbler singing on escarpment 200 feet to right. Heard grunt of Dusky Grouse toward B. Baldy (?)
- 9:30 Observed two Bibios copulating in trail. Several Bombylidae in trail.
- 9:31 Humming bird passed west in air, calling
- 9:31 Call of Dusky Grouse (?) again from Baldy.
- 9:34 Virginia Warbler warbling on escarpment 200' to right.
- 9:37 Towhee singing on bank to left one in canyon below.
- 9:35 At a point 1/2 way up 2nd valley stopped to record number of calls of several birds in two minute period. Many of the calls are from birds already recorded & are duplicates, not part of census count.

- 9:40 Two Spurred Towhees feeding and scolding
- 9:41 Virginia Warbler singing near trail, one scolding, chirping
- 9:42 Humming dove flew from top of oak & left vicinity.
- 9:43 Two S. T. Chickadees. one singing in top, the other feeding in oak below. The air was full of Bibios in great numbers. No wind & clear skies
- 9:44 Spurred Towhee singing on escarpment 400' to left.
- 9:45 Two Spurred Towhees singing on left escarpment
- 9:46 Gray headed Junco flew up 12' ^{above} into oak four feet way, checked bill on limb, then flew down on ground and commenced to feed in shadow of oak trunk, chirping when on ground.
