


- 9:56 20' from Junco a Chipping Sparrow fed, ^{and chirped} on ground in opening flew into oak. A chippy was singing least style behind.
- 9:56 Towhee singing to left on bank in top of oak. passed ^{while} & he continued to sing.
- 9:57 Jack jumped up 30' ahead & ran up trail.
- 9:59 Virginia Warbler singing at head of canyon.
- 9:52 Leaving head of 2nd valley, working left around edge of hill near top on trail. Hummer pass west, calling.
- 9:52 Spurred Towhee singing down hill to left.
- 9:52 Virginia Warbler singing 40' ahead. strings vibrate slightly when warbling.
- 9:52 After passing along trail Spurred Towhee commenced to scold 30' behind me. Did not see or hear him when passing by.
- 9:54 Virginia Warbler flew from top of oak in head & flew directly overhead & lit in oak behind to commence warbling.
- 9:54 At Divide looking down into drainage of Battle Creek lying to the north & west. Big Baldy bordering drainage to the N.E.
- 9:59 Spurred Towhee singing in canyon to left & below.
- 9:59 Sparrow Hawk flying over divide to N.W. Lawn of onions on flat portions of divide.
- 10:00 Virginia warbler singing to left in canyon 100' away.
- 10:00 Spurred Towhee singing to right 200'
- 10:01 Virginia warbler warbling on divide in oak.
- 10:02 2 Sing. Warb. sing to right below in canyon.
- 10:06 Two Spurred Towhees sing & scolding to right.
- 10:07 Two Virginia warblers fighting & flying through tops of oak.
- 10:08 Spurred Towhee singing to left on ridge.
- 10:09 Spurred " scolding to right 150' down hill.
- 10:09 2 Virginia warblers singing to right. more butterflies and insects flying in air today.
- 10:12 On top of mahogany ridge looking down into valley. Swift flew by.
- 10:13 north. west extension of ridge now looking directly down into Battle Creek below. on highest point. The falcon is sitting on tree perch on north side of small cliff about 150 feet down west ridge. Watched him for 2 minutes without being detected. was sitting on west side of tree in shade of limb, well concealed. When he finally detected my presence began to scream & continued for 4 minutes, then left perch and circled 3 times and flew up canyon around cliffs & probably lit. Very little breeze coming up over bank of canyon. Swallow still commanding same positions yesterday. Some of the younger swallows were colored with more brown on head and back. 
- 10:40 Left top to work down east ridge to station 400' below in mahogany on bank of ridge looking down into Battle & drainage above toward Timp.
- 10:43 Arrived at station.
- 10:44 Lazuli Bunting flew by & down canyon over Battle Creek Towhee singing 100' to south.
- 10:46 Two Virginia Warblers fussing & chirping in mahogany to south.
- 10:48 Heard Hummer pass, calling.
- 11:52 Have quite definitely decided that the flight of the swift is one of the commonest sites in nature but yet one of the greatest and unusual phenomena in nature.
- 11:45 Heard Chipmunk below.
- 11:45 Counted 9 swifts in air at one time. Birds continually flying & chattering.
