The snow is still carrying its
wintery appearance and still
subject to surface slides. Two
slides passed in review from
the point. Both in same tract
starting from highest point and
leaping out over lower cliffs.

1/25 x 58 clear atmosphere. Focus
at 200 feet.

Taken from same point as
on ridge between Timpone Basin and cirque on
north end of Pimpanogas, but looking into the north end
of Timpone Basin cirque.

Here again winter is in command
without any bare ridges in
evidence. The brink of the
cirque is shown in lower left
section of picture. A scraggly
fir lends an artistic touch in
contrast to a delicate background.

1/25 x 28 clear atmosphere

Same as first picture but focus
normal to accommodate distance.

1/25 x 28 clear. A miterocher
was observed flying up this ridge
toward high point. Snows slightly
wet and cold on feet contact.
Crusted before sun in morning
but on level exposure will let
one down to knees. The slide field
has suffered several slides in last
3 or four days.
