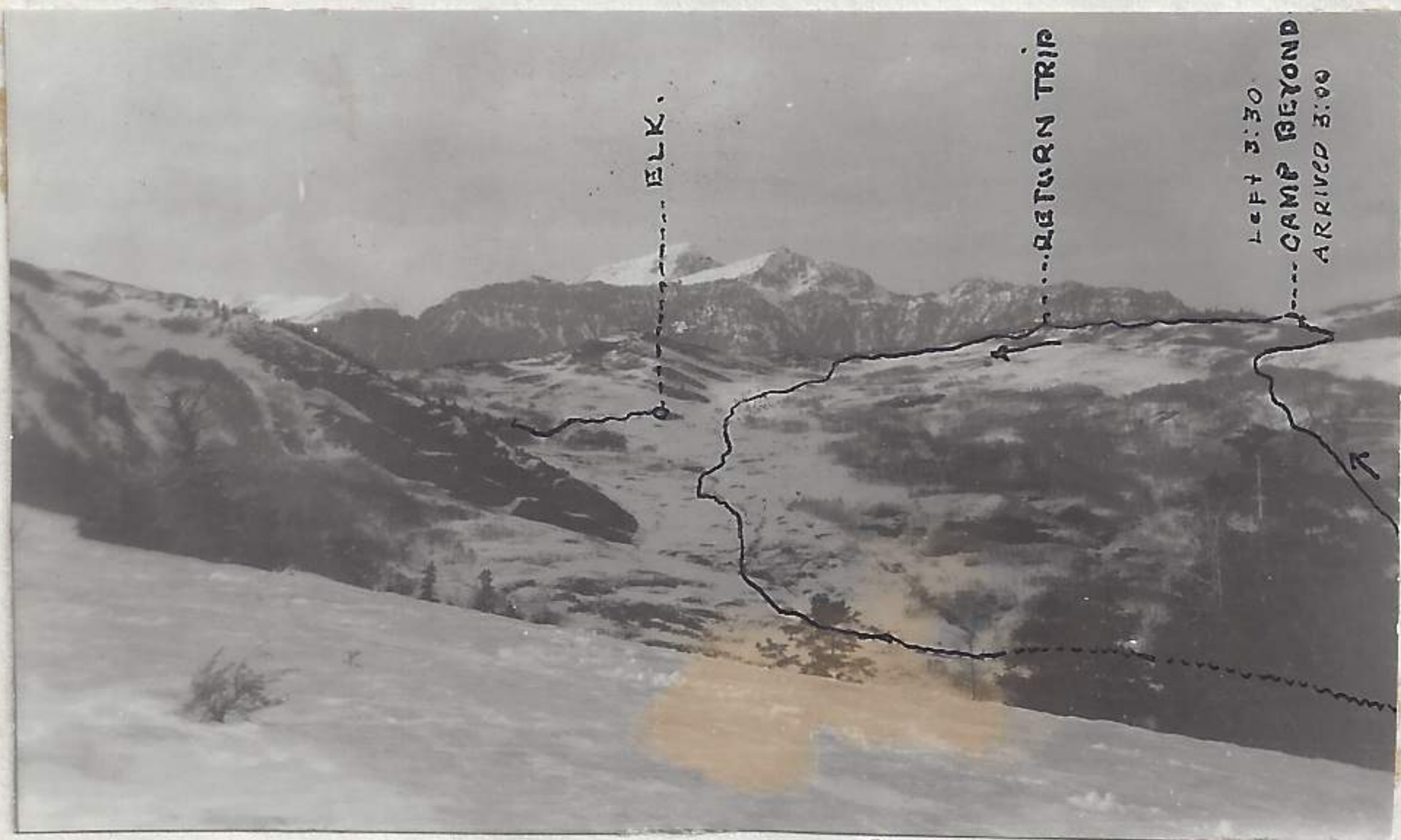

North terminal of Timpanogas under the blasts of white clouds + high winds. From ridge between Timpanoche Basin and cirque on north end of Timpanogas. The high and exposed ridges bear overlaps of snow on lee side. Several sections have broken loose and no doubt have caused snow-slides. Eagles sighted in such an atmospheric condition frequently passing through lower limits of mist clouds. $\frac{1}{25} \times 28$ clear atmosphere without purple haze.
