Placed in *Picea engelmannii* 60' high, 4' from above water, 2' overhanging ^{edge of} ~~edge of~~ creek. nest 1 foot from edge of branch. ^{nesting} ~~nesting~~ tree in group of *Picea* and nest placed on green ^{limb} ~~limb~~ directly above the lower dead branches. ^{roaring} ~~roaring~~ water ^{two} ~~two~~ young birds rested upon nest in opposite directions ^{about} ~~about~~ both conforming to trend of creek. When approached approached 2' they left one at a time but flew adeptly. nest usual but flattened, the platform having two body grooves of resting birds trending in same direction as stream. The nesting limb was protected by the upper limbs of the tree which overhang the creek 8 feet. Across from ^{site} ~~site~~ ^{Directly across from camp site.} nest no ③ B. T. Hummer. Placed in Eng. Spruce 60' + high, 74" above water, 8 foot overhang. Tree leaning over creek slightly, and nest placed on first green bow above the lower dead limbs. nest 1 foot from outer peripheral edge of branch. The young had hatched from this nest. nest placed on 45° dipping branch. At camp site ^{abutting against opposite} nest no ④ B. T. Hummer. Placed in *Picea* eng. leaning slightly over water. Tree 5' high and nest 4' above water, 1 1/2' overhanging ^{edge} ~~edge~~ of creek bank. Small tree unshaded by larger ⁱⁿ ~~in~~ tree but in association with small trees which were close ^{8' from road} ~~8' from road~~. Two weeks ago it ~~had~~ was 1/4 constructed. Bird setting with head down stream. 1 foot from peripheral edge of limb. Tree entirely green below
