

and number is placed in separate book & field in field book, & the animal can be taken out of trap. Now the animal has field number which is duplicated in field book and collection number book. As soon as one returns to camp place all animals in traps near table for recording. Then place collection number book on table, field book directly right of collection book and skin tag and skull tag to right of collection number book. Now place one of the specimens in trap on table to left of collection number book. List it in C.N. book its locality, date and collector. It has received its collection number now & this number is then placed in a long circle in field book corresponding to same animal. Now fill in skin tags and skull tag indicating collection number and after taking specimen out of trap place on ^{long} board with tag associated with it. The specimen can be measured when giving collection number or can be measured after all specimens are recorded first. This method is systematic and saved time as well as illuminating possibility of error.

(4) Record observations as they are made. Do not put off until a shady spot turns up or leave until one returns to camp. Notes made on the spot are the only scientific ones. Make deduction from notes and not in field.
