2. 730 J.B *Microtus m.* In supersaturated area among 2" grasses.

1. 735 J.B *Microtus m. mordax*. In runway in supersaturated boggy ground 30' from lake edge and near willows. While on trap line a rail left high sedge of the lake shore and swam across the open water in middle of lake to other side. While swimming across picked up the insects on the surface and offered a sharp call the entire period it was on the water. Am doubtful as to species but looked to me like the Virginia rail although it had a yellow bill like the sora. A Audubon warbler fed in willows along lake edge. Met a negro sheep herder at lake and he informs me that the winter two years ago was extremely cold while this last winter was very mild. This spring he says is backward and is generally windy and cloudy. The feed is growing slowly. In returning from lake to camp inspected oak patch on hillside. The leaves are just beginning to grow and are from 1/2" to 3" long and from a distance have a yellow color. Back to camp to prepare material.
