

12:00 Two vultures circled above aspen trees at camp. Raven flying with them for short distance then turned away.

738 J.B. *Microtus m.m.* Six embryos averaging 12 m.m. in curled position. One 1/2 as large as the rest. Mammary glands well developed.

739 J.B. *Eutamias amoenus*. Uterus normal. Mammary glands well developed.

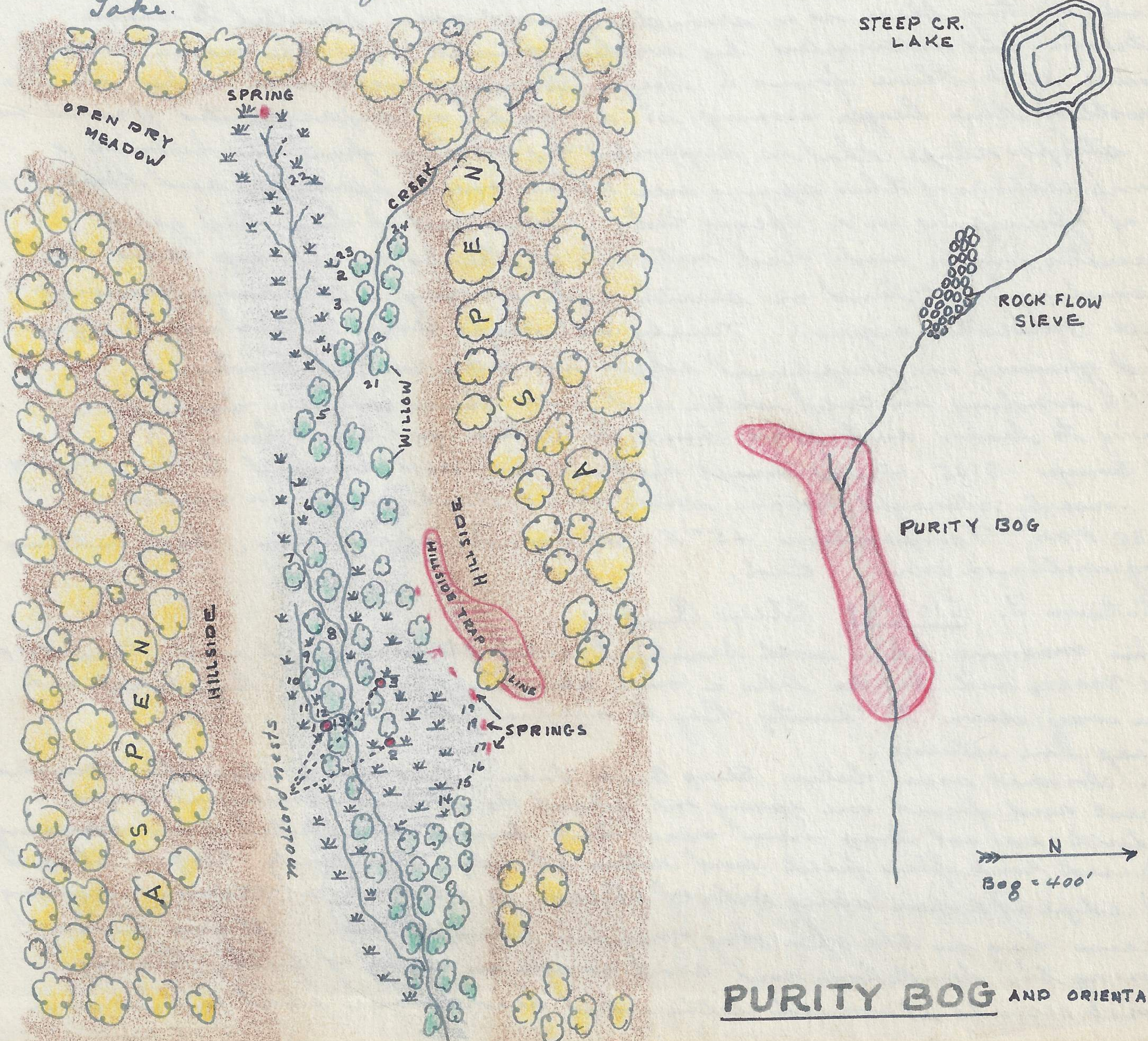
741 J.B. *Peromyscus*. Testis 7 m.m. long.

12:25 P.M. Thrush singing.

12:30 P.M. Lincoln Sparrow chipping in willow on opposite side of swamp. Flew across field to edge of swamp below cabin and commenced to feed.

2:30 P.M. Temperature 68°F.

Finish work at 4:00 P.M. and prepared to start out on trap line. Before leaving stepped out into swamp and George found Lincoln Sparrow nest of four eggs. Nest placed in bunch of grass 1' high at base. Nest 2 feet from flowing water and wet soils surrounding. Near willows. Nest of dried stems lined with horse hair. 100 feet N. E. of cabin and directly east 20' from where sidehill stream enters swamp. Left for trapping grounds at Purity Bog below Steep Creek Lake.
