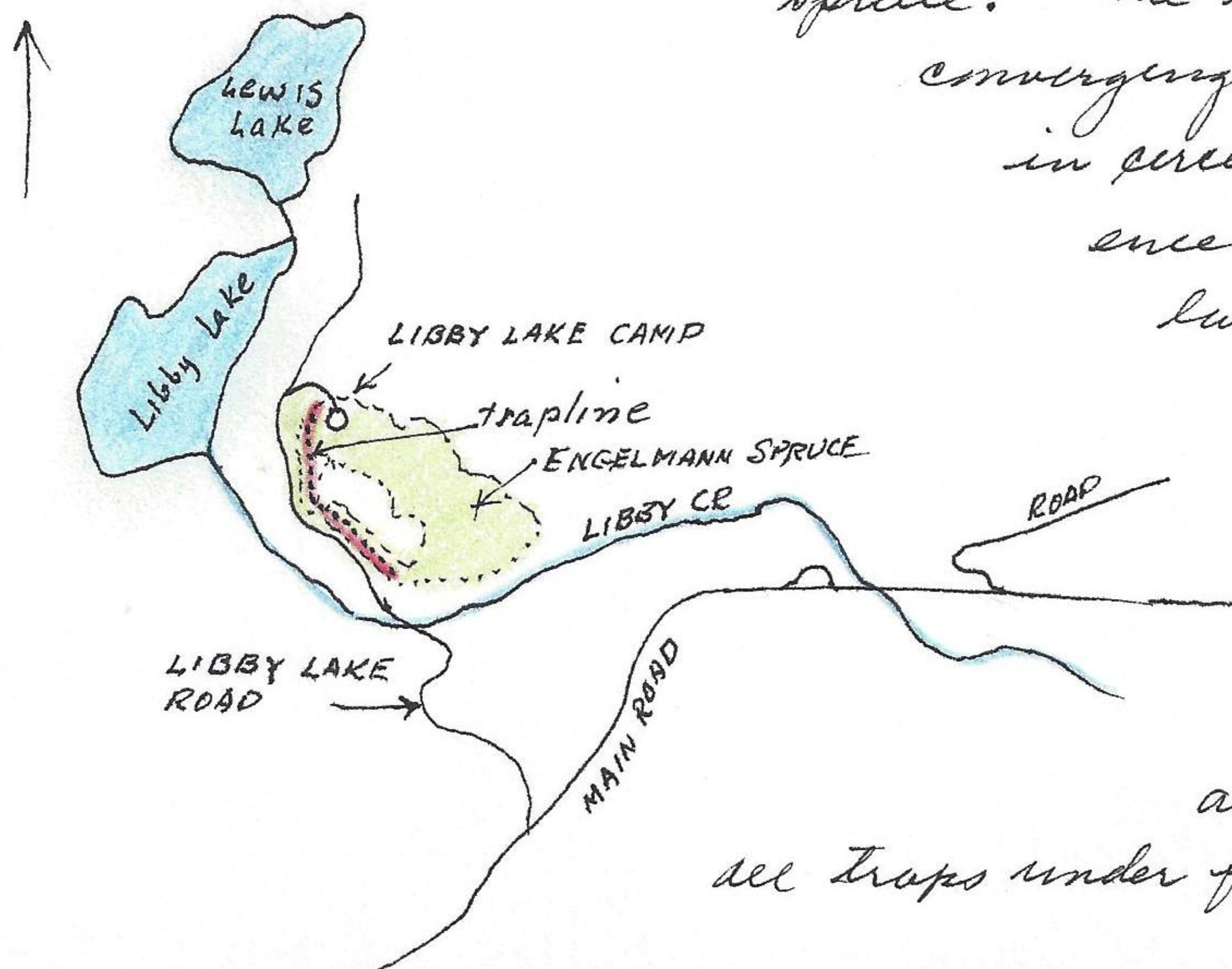

Sores 800804-1 had 12/10 grams of mammary tissue on body. The embryos are arranged thus:



The trapline⁽⁵⁰⁾ of the above catch was set in the evening of last yesterday from west side of Libby Camp grounds S for 1000 feet between the ridge and the main road below. This side hill is of Engelmann spruce. One large tree of 2 trunks



converging at base measured 216 inches in circumference or 18' circumference. These are some of the largest spruce before the dwarf conifers of the alpine and timberline. Ground covered with fallen logs and minimum ground cover. Dry and dusty from road below. all traps under fallen logs & protected from rain.
