

1. Unaffected. Edge of water. (Starting from head of spring.)

3. " " Under protection of spruce. 3 feet from water edge.
4. " " In grasses at stream edge.
5. " " " " " " " "
6. 777 J.B. *Microtus mordax mordax*. Along side of water in muddy surface with grasses growing in it. Near spruce trees.
7. Unaffected. Under protection of large spruce where no vegetation grows. Six feet from water edge.
8. Unaffected. Marshy grasses in standing water at convergence of lower ^{side} spring.
9. Unaffected. Along wet creek side where grasses almost choke creek.
10. Unaffected. Base of spruce three feet from water. Dead spruce needles, grasses & mosses cover the surface.
11. Unaffected. Side of large boulder along creek edge.
12. Unaffected. In center of small spruce growth three feet from water edge.
13. Unaffected. Edge of spruce and large boulder six feet from H₂O.
14. " " Base of spruce in stunted growth.
15. " " Among dead willow & spruce 18' from head of spring.
16. Sprung. Along side of dead aspen log lying across boggy area adjoining head of spring.
17. Unaffected. Bordering spring along side of boulder.
18. Sprung - but remaining. Among boulders a few feet from head of spring by aspen tree. A cow trail crossed at this point between two boulders and required the small animal to almost step into trap. Started the above set of traps at head of spring and set down to lateral spring on west side of water course, then back again to head of spring on east side. Beyond the six foot zone of damp stream edge is a 10'-30' zone of short green grass type of vegetation. Beyond this zone toward the aspen covered hillside to the east is the taller bunch and curly grass association which invades aspen growths.
19. Unaffected. Under protection of spruce 4 feet from edge of water.

22. " " Under protection of spruce tree 4' from creek.
23. " " Under ledge of large igneous boulder at base of spruce tree.
24. Unaffected. Under stunted growth of spruce with wet green grasses surrounding. 10' from edge of water.
25. Unaffected. On mud among grasses at edge of stream at convergence of two springs. Traps from 19-25 along either side of creek from convergence of two springs down to the 300' mark below head of Survivor Spring proper.
