

Little Chalet, Sundance, Mt. Tumpaganas, Utah.

April 7, 1981

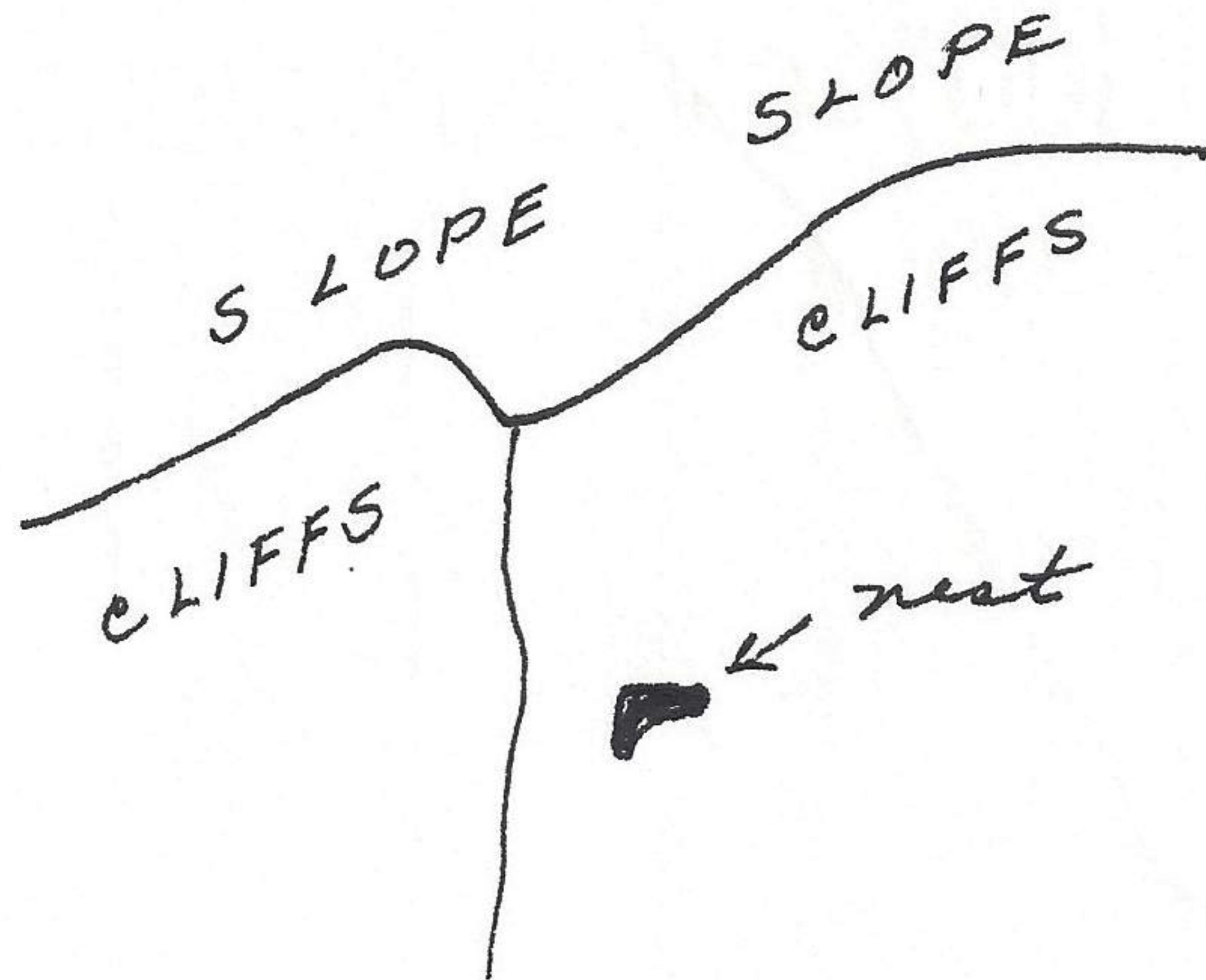
B.P. 150/88 46 pulse.

3 Steller jays consistently at feeding station shortly after feed was set out. A Goshawk flew past overhead. *Eutamias amoenus* at feeder.

Left for Heber this A.M. for supplies at 30943.6 mileage to Heber (incremental) main canyon road in Stewart Canyon .5 mi; lodge .5 mi; N Fork Road .2 mi; Wildwood 2.3 mi; Deer Creek Dam 3.9 mi; Heber 12.5 mi. or 19.9 miles from Little Chalet to Heber.

On return trip checked golden eagle nest from road at mouth of north fork. The nest is on S side of ^{Prouse} canyon in high cliffs. The birds were not seen but a nest was placed thus in cliff.

This nest had been used in previous years and eggs were laid then.



Returned to Little Chalet at Sundance and placed suet outside of kitchen window.

In 1/2 minute 2 mt chickadees fed on suet. The Steller's jay consumed most of the sunflower seeds, the chipmunks next in order. Chickadee favorite food available is suet first and then sunflower seeds. Robins did not eat suet or seeds. juncos like small seeds.

At one time at feeder were:

- 3 Steller's jays (constant)
- 3 gray-headed juncos
- 1 Oregon junco.
- 3 chickadees (2 mt., 1 black-capped)
- 2 brown creepers
- 1 robin.

Today temp 40°F with clouded skies most of day, occasional snow but disappeared as soon as it landed on the ground. One red-tailed hawk passed W overhead. This has been the first day that there has been a full complement of food in feeder area.
