min temp 24°F and snow started 7:30 AM and lasted until 10:30 A.M., 2 inches accumulation, ^{we} left at 809.7 at 10:30 AM and still snowing a little. Last evening on Casper mt, no antelope, 17 and 7 and 14 and 8 and 10 individual mule deer in loop road at base of mt just west of main road. These deer were feeding in yards of residents without residential complaint, rather than beyond human habitation. 828.4 golden eagle flying 20' above ground and hunting. 831.9 N Platte River Bridge on W side. 40 Canada geese in field, no small birds so far. 832.2 3 horn larks. 832.7 ² horned larks. 832.8 3 horned larks. 847.8 2 horned larks. 854.0 2 horned larks, horned lark. 854.4 Horse Creek. 858.3 horned lark. 859.0 2 horned larks 100' apart, 2 and 2. 860.2 horned lark. 861.2 horned lark, no road kills of any kind. 862.0 horned lark, horned lark. 863.7 Independence Rock 864.3 Sweetwater River. Road now steaming and all snow off the road. Snow beyond road. 880.2 lakes, 2 short necked geese sp.?, one group 20 horned larks. 882.7 muddy Gap junction. 886.8 Crow.
