

Fort Bridger Historical Monument, Uinta Co., Wyoming
 march 25, 1982

Left Fort Bridger at 8: A.M. mileage 1106.2 min temp
 8°F, 8000' elev. Canada geese called all morning
 and 7 flew by. (1-3-1-2) Robin only other bird observed.
 no wind, sky clear. 106.8 Black Fork River, water normal
 108.8 5 magpies feeding on freshly killed jackrabbit in middle
 of road. ^{on approach to 80.} now on 80 and going west. 116.7 2 magpies.
 119.3 freshly killed mule deer 120.5 now in juniper pinyons
 will keep complete census 125.1 robin. 126.6 now
 some aspens in canyon at floor level. 7900 ft. 126.6
 magpie. Snow shows erosion of winds coming down
 canyon from SW to N.E. Occasional deer track in
 snow. 128.5 nest in aspen and looks like a redtail
 nest in size and position. 137.3 Bear River Bridge.
 143.2 Utah State line. at 9:07 A.M. Large rabbit tracks in
 snow. 145.1 3 crows. white-tail rabbit tracks most
 common tracks. Coyote tracks cross snow fields on
 slopes in straight lines and most frequently paralleling
 snow cornices. not much evidence of deer trails.
 water and ice in creeks and ponds. 153.4 raven (2).
 Ponds 1/2 ice. There are more tracks in snow now we
 are in the canyon than on slopes of open country we
 have passed thru and there is an increase in deer
 tracks. 162.1 mule deer road kill and 2 magpies.
 164.5 3 magpies. Deer tracks in every situation in
 canyon and are increasing as we travel down grade.
 166.2 road kill mule deer. 170.5 rest stop by high
 red cliffs. 176.1 yellow leaved willow. Have
 passed beyond junction to Ogden. 176.5 exit to 115 to
 Henefer. now on 84 W. 178.2 magpie. 1826.1 mule deer
 road kill. 188.9 overpass at main street of Morgan.
 194.1 magpie. noticeable lack of blackbirds. At beginning
 of Ogden Canyon, deer tracks 1/30 of those at rest stop area
 in canyon of the red cliffs (see 170.5). 207.0 magpie.
 First startling at mouth Weber Canyon. 209.9 magpies
 210.3 exit 91. striped skunk road kill. now on 84-15
 going N. 212.1 striped skunk road kill, 2 magpie.
 214.0 first Calif gull 223.5 pheasant. 225.9 magpie
 228.6 Perry Turnoff. Golden eagle in canyon directly
 E., circling above at same elevation as 10 Calif gulls
