Left Port Townsend at 12:56. mileage 80.4. This A.M. rainy skies and wind to 30 MPH. Temp. cool. more leaves on trees than when we first arrived. Flowers just beginning and some out but nothing like they will be a week or so from now. 91.9 creek at Discovery Bay (S end) at 2:44. Bay with 1/2 mile tidal flats and gulls about every 40' apart as one reaches the outer limits of the bay. Some trees are in inflorescences. 99.9 Callam Co. Occasional Crow but birdlife rare thru this area. 109.9 Sequim. Have never seen so many dandelions as are in the fields. 131.7 to Heart of the Hills in Olympic N. Park. 132.9 Camp Grounds at Heart of the Hills. Birds at Camp: Canada jays (4), robin 2, 2 ♂ ♀ mallards, roven. This evening made trip up trail toward Lake Angeles starting at trail head at 5:33 P.M. p. 68 at 6:00 P.M. a short distance along trail. 6:03 P.M. first minor switch back (snowing). 6:09 snow patches in main Canyon below, p. 68 6:17 big rocks. 6:24 first snow patch in trail. no wildlife, no dead shrews.
