

At 7:05 P.M. 3 Caspian terns flew by to S.

Kalalock State Park, Jefferson Co., Washington
May 2, 1982

Surf 10-15 segments and covered with a white foam. Cormorants 1 per 5 min flying S at outer ocean side of surf. 2-10 common & surf scoters feeding inward from first outer breaker. They dive at approaching wave or ride over wave if considered rideable. Accidents or reflexes a second before wave comes in. Occasionally one is caught as wave breaks and the scoter is pushed with the wave either badly ^{in swimming position} or completely out of control, turning over several times before gaining control. Gulls fly past about every 5 min. (1 to 4 gulls). Robins most common bird at camp and other than crows are about the only ^{land} birds present. Drove down to lodge restaurant to S which is along a river and bordering N.P. to N. and observed, robin, robin, robin, robin, robin, robin, crow, robin, crow. At lodge group 2 oyster catchers and 1 single bird. Gulls to lawn outside restaurant window. Picked up hat that was left there by Chris on her honey-moon trip to Quinalt Lake. Returned to camp at Kalalock and made several pictures of Annette & tree at camp; 820502-1 Annette and large conifer at camp, 820502-2 ibid. 820502-3 ibid. to S, 820502-4 camp from beach. 820502-5 surf from camp.

May 3, 1982

Hummingbird, yellow warbler, song sparrow and Steller jay along with robins and crows. A white-fronted goose walked along edge of water (it had a broken wing) and when near us left beach and swam out thru surf, riding all waves rather than diving. Many times the crest of a wave would carry the goose backwards or sideways for 5-15 ft, most of the time in a toppling uncontrolled movement. Forward progress was slow but steady and I could imagine painful. Collected perfectly round basaltic rocks and shipped to Lawrence.

May 4, 1982

Left Kalalock 10:45 at mileage 276.4 (43817.8) 3 mi. S Nat'l Park headquarters visited Mrs. Joe Burke who had a home share house. Before and during severe winter storms the logs are piled high on beach. 286.5 Jefferson County 290.1 Gray-
