Steel-headed salmon are in this river. 111.0 2 Steller jays. Have been recorded complete census. Now up & over the first range. Some broom at this elevation. 114.8 first cottonwoods. River bed dry. 115.8 elev. 2000 ft. 118.0 top divide (Oregon Mt Pass, 2888 ft, 129.9 Weavertown, intense red soils. There is sameness thru Trinity Valley. 141.2 3000 ft. 142.0 Shasta Co. 146.3 more trees but more sparsely placed. Long needle pine still present. All birds observed have been recorded. N side Whiskey Reservoir. Rocks telling and darker, ^{brown, yellow:} greenish & reds. higher fragmented. 160.5 Shasta. 165.9 Redding at Rail-road overpass. Large 2 1/2' palm trees in city. 167.4 middle bridge Sacramento River, at 7:07 P.M. Just east of Redding is an oak, 30' high with light green leaves. oak bark and dominating forest. 173.8 maple. 175.3 Cow Creek, can see part of Lassen Mt, opossum road kill. occasional ponderosa pine on ridges. Occasional barn swallow and about the only birds in Redding Valley. 179.1 first redwing. Have seen what appears like Brewers blackbirds. Delicate light colored needle pine still in area. 183.2 2000 ft 179.1 2-3 miles E Shingleton at rest stop arriving at 8:03 P.M. Plan to go back to Shingleton to have tapets checked tomorrow.
