 between the cultivated areas and the deserts to W. 966.7
 marsh hawk. 5000 at 7:00 P.M. at mileage in Utah ←
 approaching Nephi. Summation of birds from Hinkley
 to Nephi. jackrabbit road kills average 1 per $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile but
 varied according to vegetation and land profile, some places
 1 every 300 ft. decided increase in Brewers blackbirds
 from Hinkley E. Occasional magpie (3). many W. kingbirds
 probably 1 per $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 mile, 3 great blue herons, gulls (Calif),
 Beyond Nephi N on 15 getting to dark to observe and end
 of census. Arrived Provo at 64.6 at 10:00 P.M. ^{at} Mary
 and Don Jensens at 1593 N, 1450 E 84601. They are expected to
 318. return in a day or two.
