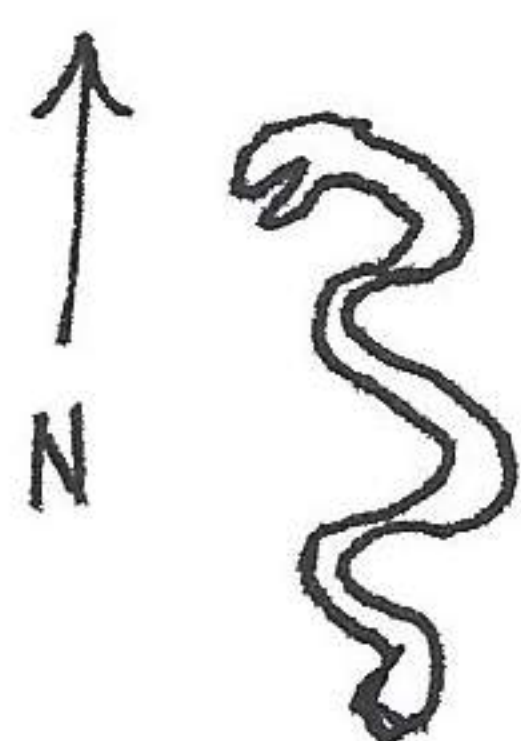
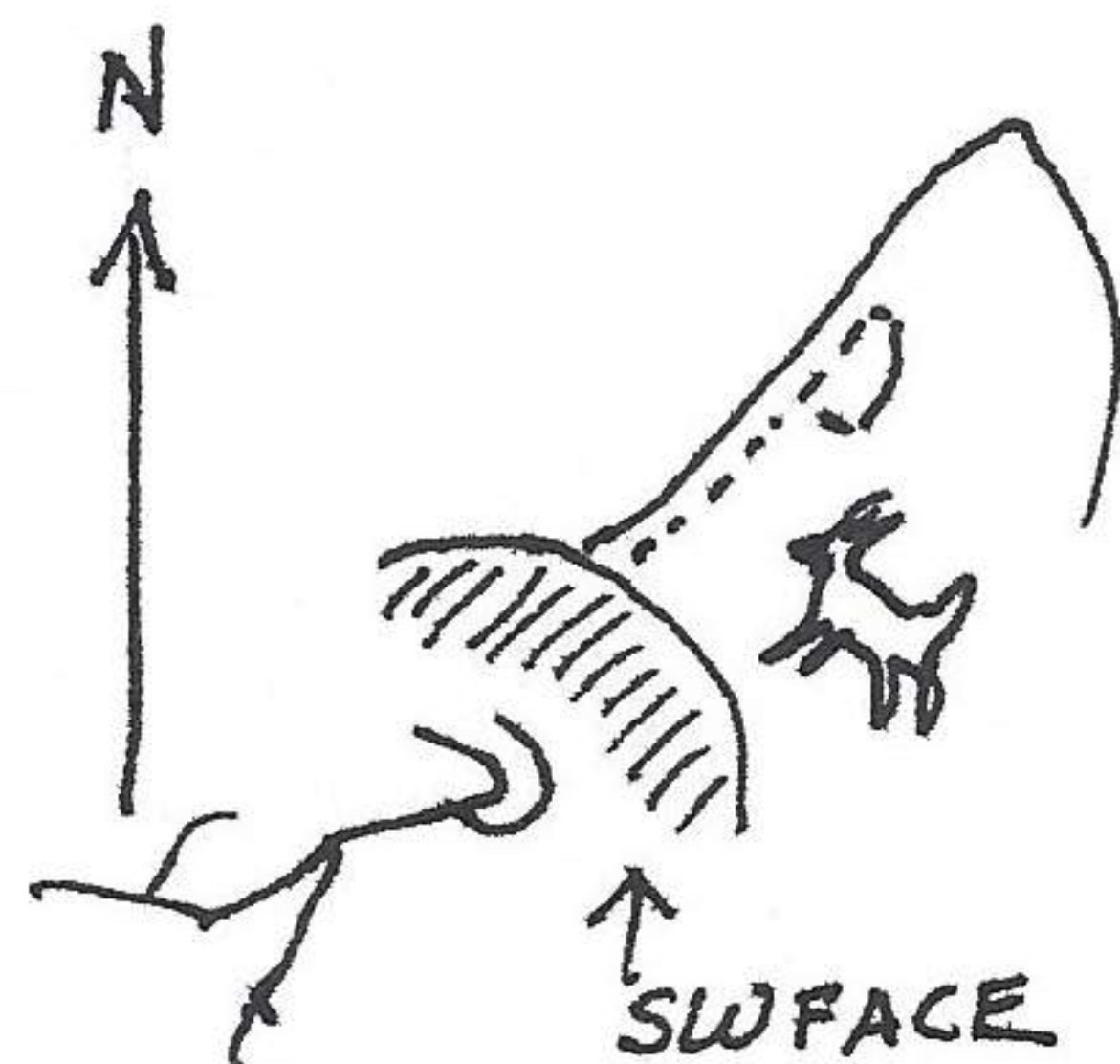


1:10 P.M. first grasshopper. 1:11 yellow warbler, towhee. 1:17 pipe flume. Between bridge and pipeline, on trail, 7 sets of deer droppings, one track measured 78 mm. 1:25 golden eagle with no white in tail circled above petroglyph site. Calif. gulls in small group of 5-12 flying high to E up Canyon. Check land management marker at site (NE corner Springdell property. ^{SC} T55 | R3E made some orientation checks

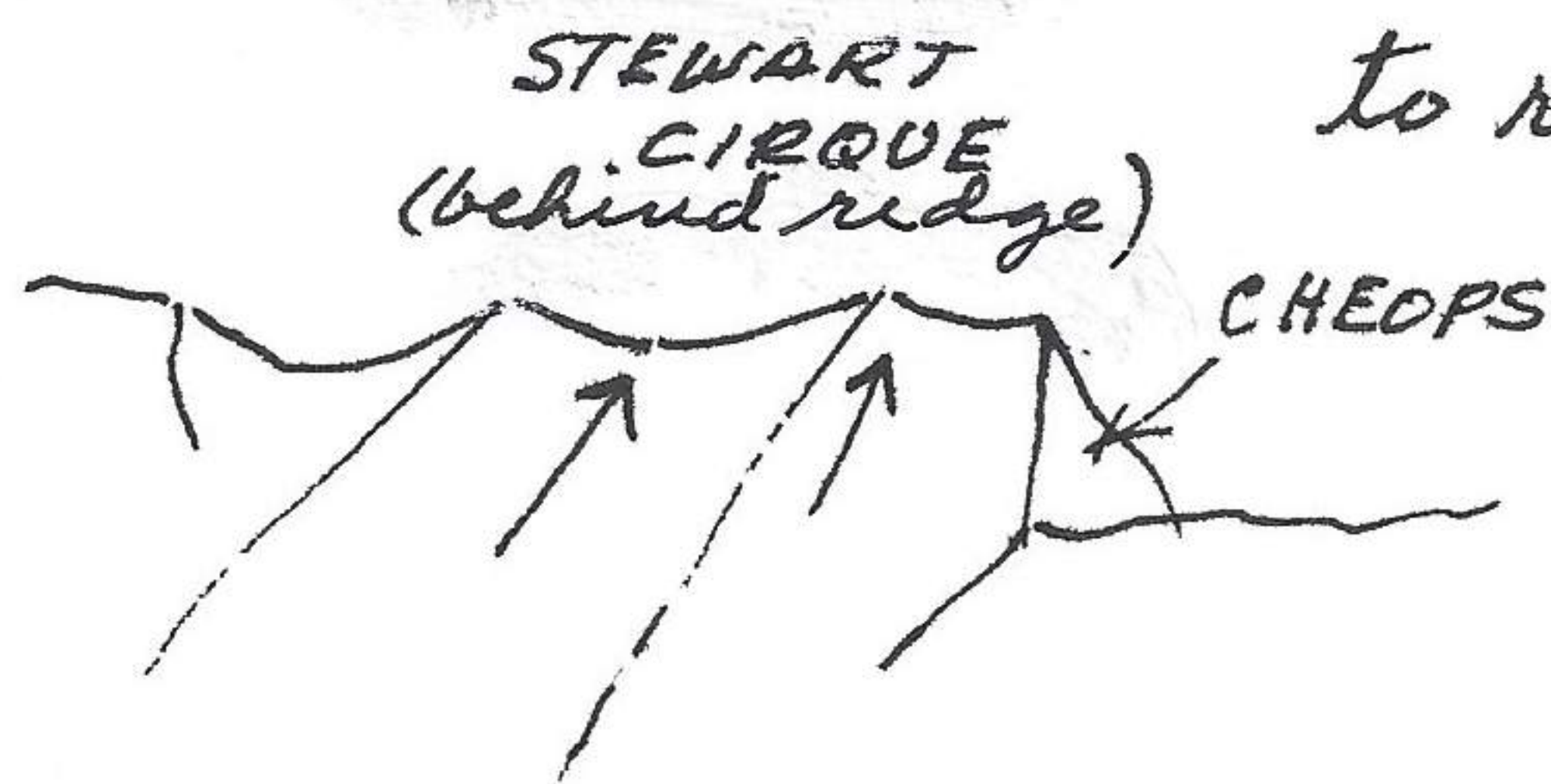

16 Calif gulls flew W over site 75' above ground. mule deer make and maintain trails thru site and on slopes to river below. Droppings common.



arrows on SW face of Timp show where wind gathers snow on W side Timp and flows over ridge into Stewart Cirque on E side Timp.

Cornices form all along ridge on east side. Second arrow (R) contributed mainly to Bee Glacier.

Little Chalet, Sundance, Mt. Timpanogos, Utah Co., Utah.
May 17, 1982

First day at Mary + Son's Chalet at Stewart's Flat at Sundance. Skiing Resort. Maple leaves just beginning, oaks (scrub) not yet started. Golden eagle nest (lower right) with green conifer branches, upper left as of last year. Put food stations out.

May 18, 1982

Put food out on 17th but not visited by birds or mammals.
