

- 3 *Citellus armatus*, group 4 mourning doves in open area.
- 8:38 *Citellus armatus*. 8:38 *Citellus armatus*. now passing morton's Cabin, life like statue visible in E window.
- 8:39 yellow-bellied or Williamson sapsucker, probably the latter, it made considerable noise and action within 10 feet.
- also 8 *Citellus armatus*, 8:41 road to timber. From here to end of road on E side slope of knoll (left terminal) 9:10 starting traverse up slope 20 *Citellus armatus*, sapsucker, 2 western tanager, deer tracks 96, 83, 70 mm. Top 9:30 A.M. As I approached top James Robert came down trail from top. at first I did not recognize him because he had a new hair cut, closely trimmed that changed his appearance. We continued to top and there made several photos as follows:
