

long-eared Owls in bottom of canyon. These owls kept in the bottom of canyon at all times and were seen on several occasions. Heard Gnatcatcher calling in a screening mechanical manner. Six *Baeolophus inornatus griseus* were feeding in canyon among the junipers. Their call is similar to the chickadee and until it is heard several times one would confuse it with the chickadee. Collected a (806 J.B) Cottontail 2 blocks below tanks in junipers and piñon with Artemisia and chrysothamnus patches near. At forks below camp heard gnatcatcher calling. also Rock Wren and two *Eutamias*. Was in bottom of canyon when I heard *Eutamias* and started in after them. They were wild about for they all lead me a merry chase and without even getting a shot at them.

- Trap no. 11 B. (705 J.B) *Dipodomys ordii cupidinus*. Sandy canyon floor at base of Artemisia bush. Piñons & firs surrounded. Just east of overhanging Shinaronip formation

- 7 (802 J.B) *Peromyscus*. Caught at entrance to hole. Several other holes and fresh dirt was associated with this hole. appeared to me to be similar to *Dipodomys* holes
- 15. (801 J.B) *Peromyscus truei*. At cave among boulders of collapsed roof.

Collected (807 J.B) *Dendroica nigrescens* feeding in piñons at bottom of canyon at forks. at 9:06 A.M. Overcast skies and no wind. Also this morning saw a Jack rabbit, a *Myiarchus cinerascens cinerascens*, and several swifts flying above canyon. Back to camp. 9:50. Temperature then 69° F. Autoclaved these specimens and measured the cottontail. (806 J.B) Skull only.
