

820523-19 To S down Scatts Hollow. Provo Canyon middle - ground and head S. Fork Provo Canyon in distance.

820523-20 *ibid.*

820523-21 To N with head N. Fork of Provo Canyon and Granite Range to N.

820523-22 Robert Redford's Chateau & ancillary building at Sundance area.

820523-23 Clearview Point on Clearview moraine, N side Stewart Canyon. Conifer just left of center of photo is vantage point. Open meadow to rear & right.

820523-24 Avalanche canyon to N/SW of photo station, showing path taken by avalanche along course of least resistance. Two other paths are indicated. Greater volumes of snow could send the avalanche out in most any direction on the alluvial fan at mouth of canyon.

820523-25. Avalanche from S out of canyon which in turn is supplied by a canyon off of Ashley Peak (E slope). This avalanche could shift directly into castle built at edge of usual avalanche channel. A more massive avalanche beyond out of Overwhelm Canyon. Cabins at upper reach of Stewart Canyon could be destroyed by avalanches out of these canyons and off of Elk Peak, Facet Peak and Stewart Crag. There has been unusually extensive avalanches into the canyon below Stewart Falls but not massive enough to carry the avalanche E down canyon into area of cabins. These property owners should be advised as to the potential danger of these avalanches.

Left top at 10:25 A.M. 2 goldfinches. One Cooper hawk flew S over top. On W side on extensively cut ski run noted a solitaire, one western tanager, 1 mt. blue-bird and 6 pine siskins. 3 redtail hawks around secondary knoll to N. *Citellus armatus* all the way to top and from the top down. At bend of road at base of hill as road trends N, 5 mule deer tracks crossed road on snow. Continued down road to above Cabin (Little Chalet), thence straight down to road that leaves main road and enters Little Chalet area. Little Chalet at 11:10 A.M. At first cabin W of Little Chalet, just beyond moraine chalet, a Cooper hawk flew over grass lawn not more than 6" from the surface and at
