maple leaves now from 1/2" to 3" and obscuring vision thru trees. Oaks just beginning to produce leaves. 4 turkey vultures circled above Sundance area and then flew N. Jack Hapkinson, Son & Marip neighbor with big cabin to NE of the Little Chalet and at end of moraine says he has not seen eagles in the last 3 years. Redford gave money to B.U.U. to research eagles and hawks in the area. Student used his second floor porch to observe the birds. Banded some redtails that nested in conifers on S side of canyon. 5 deer come to his yard every 3 days. They have a trail that crosses the moraine between his house and the Little Chalet. In his cabin he has a veritable historical museum. One bear trap (steel jaw) approx. 4 feet long. Others smaller. The furniture antiques come from Mapleton, Ogden, Idaho, southern Utah and Provo.

at 12:05 P.M. left aspen and followed trail up thru conifer forests to ridge (at water tank) thence on horizontal trail to Stewart's Flat (Little Chalet). 8 robins in open field at aspen.
