 820524-37 Mary, James R + Annette in open field below Stewart's flat. The lower falls in lower right hand corner is subject of several photos above. Several avalanches on S side of valley off Ashley Peak. Extensive aspen and other trees areas have been effected by avalanches in this field below falls but none reaching cabins. A dead porcupine along side of creek probably killed by avalanche. Along trail between aspen & Stewart Falls noted many Cetellus arnatus, butterflies uncommon but included anglewing, morning cloak and cabbage butterflies. At least 2 tree squirrels, one aspen 1 foot in diameter and yellowish green, hairy woodpecker (at 1:06 P.M.) 5 pine siskin, gray-headed juncos. Did not see eagles or hear ruffed grouse.

Little Chalet, Sundance, Mt. Timpanogos, Utah Co., Utah  
 May 25, 1982

BP 140/72. Checked golden eagles this A.M. from moraine chalet. At 8:30 A.M. an adult eagle flew past nest (previous notes for location) on lower cliffs of NW side Ashley Peak opposite terraces out of Cheops cirque. Same height as nest and bird low enough to be below top of conifers. This eagle was large with conspicuous yellowish-gold head. I presume this to be the ♀ of the pair. 8:35 A.M. another smaller eagle with some variation of white in tail, presumably the ♂ of the pair and younger than ♀, flew by nest as did the ♀ at 8:30 A.M. and then alighted on nest. At 8:38 the ♂? left nest and glided down to top of a spruce below nesting cliff and nest and after awkwardly adjusting balance remained for a few seconds and then left. 8:45 while watching the eagles a broadtailed hummingbird hit window on W side chalet moraine and dropped to bill for 30 seconds and then flew out into a conifer tree. 5 other broadtailed hummingbirds and 3 black-chinned hummers have been picked up dead from below these large windows. If this number, 8, is timed by say 100 cabins in the area the total number of hummers killed would be 800 which could be the population of humming birds in the area. 8:50 A.M. no activity of
