

along along Level Ridge that is a continuation of the middle Peak, took several photos of the surrounding area. Photo 820528-17 to S showing Ancient Peak in foreground to left, Seattle Canyon beyond and Overturn Canyon beyond snow patch on ridge. Provo Canyon is between the last mentioned ridge and the Cascade Range beyond. The drainage above below the highest peak, ^{on Cascade Range} is drainage of Bridal Veil Falls in Provo Canyon. Remnant Pass below ~~and~~ this side of Ancient Peak is ^{one of} the original drainages off Timpanogas to W. Since then the intervening area has eroded down to present drainage system to N. ^{to} S. Faulting along E side Timpanogas also may have contributed to the abandonment of ^{one of} the original drainages thru the Remnant Pass.

Photo 820528-20 From Level Ridge to WSW showing upper terminal of Squaw Knife Ridge. Beyond to W of this terminal is the perpendicular walls of Cheops Cirque. It is my guess the Redford will some day extend his ski lifts to this upper terminal.

Photo 820528-21 From Level Ridge SW to Cascade Range. Below peak is drainage of Bridal Veil Falls. May they never allow ski slopes in this N + E exposure of Cascade Range.

Photo 820528-22 From Level Ridge to S showing drainages from Cascade Range out of photo to right and in background, Provo Peak, Peak at head of Rock Canyon and Cirque walls 2 of Windy Pass. This Cirque drains into S Fork Provo Canyon. Other 2 peaks in distance into Rock Canyon.

Photo 820528-23 From Level Ridge to W showing upper basin of Stewart Cirque, Cheops, exit of Cheops Cirque and north limb of Ashley Peak to left.

Photo 820528-24 From Level Ridge to NWN showing N end of Stewart Cirque to left and Facet Peak to right. The east end of basal stratum of Stewart Cirque turn up which may be an illusion.
