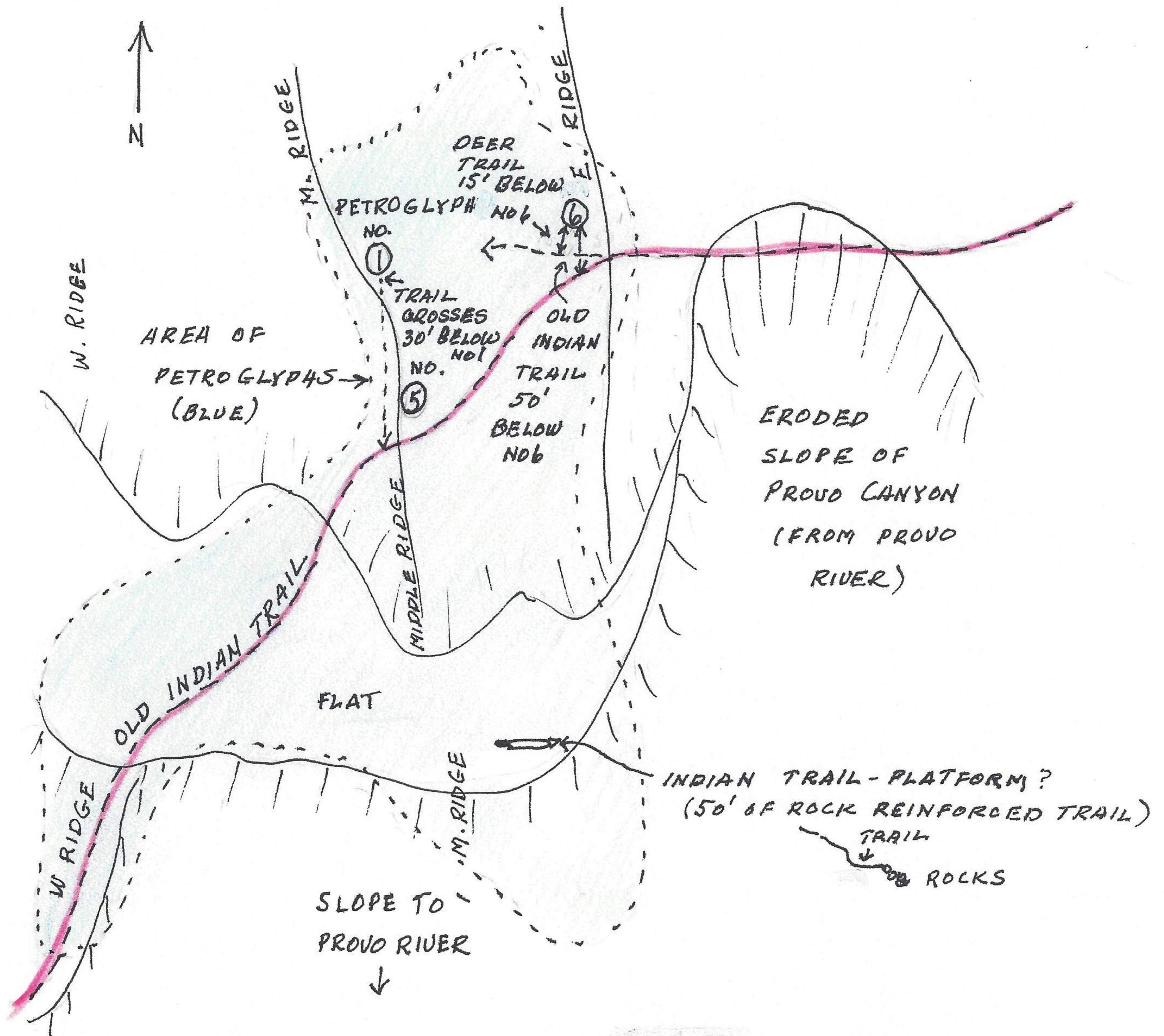


There has been several different marker sites (piled rocks and poles) established in the past (by private concerns?) trying to establish the Township - Range interception (intersection). Established course of old Indian Trail petroglyph site, especially as it relates to petroglyph no. 6 which suggests a trail, hunting theme. (no. 6 = 670815-6 JWB).



The trail across upper eroded slope of Provo Canyon is well preserved and shows that trail construction was practiced for convenience of travel. This trail could have by-passed this eroded slope by going up over ridge but Indians preferred to construct trail which connected to easy bench access trail beyond. This trail leads to forested spring area that I predict will support camp sites. A more likely route to the east side of Timpangos would not be by Provo Canyon to Wildwood
