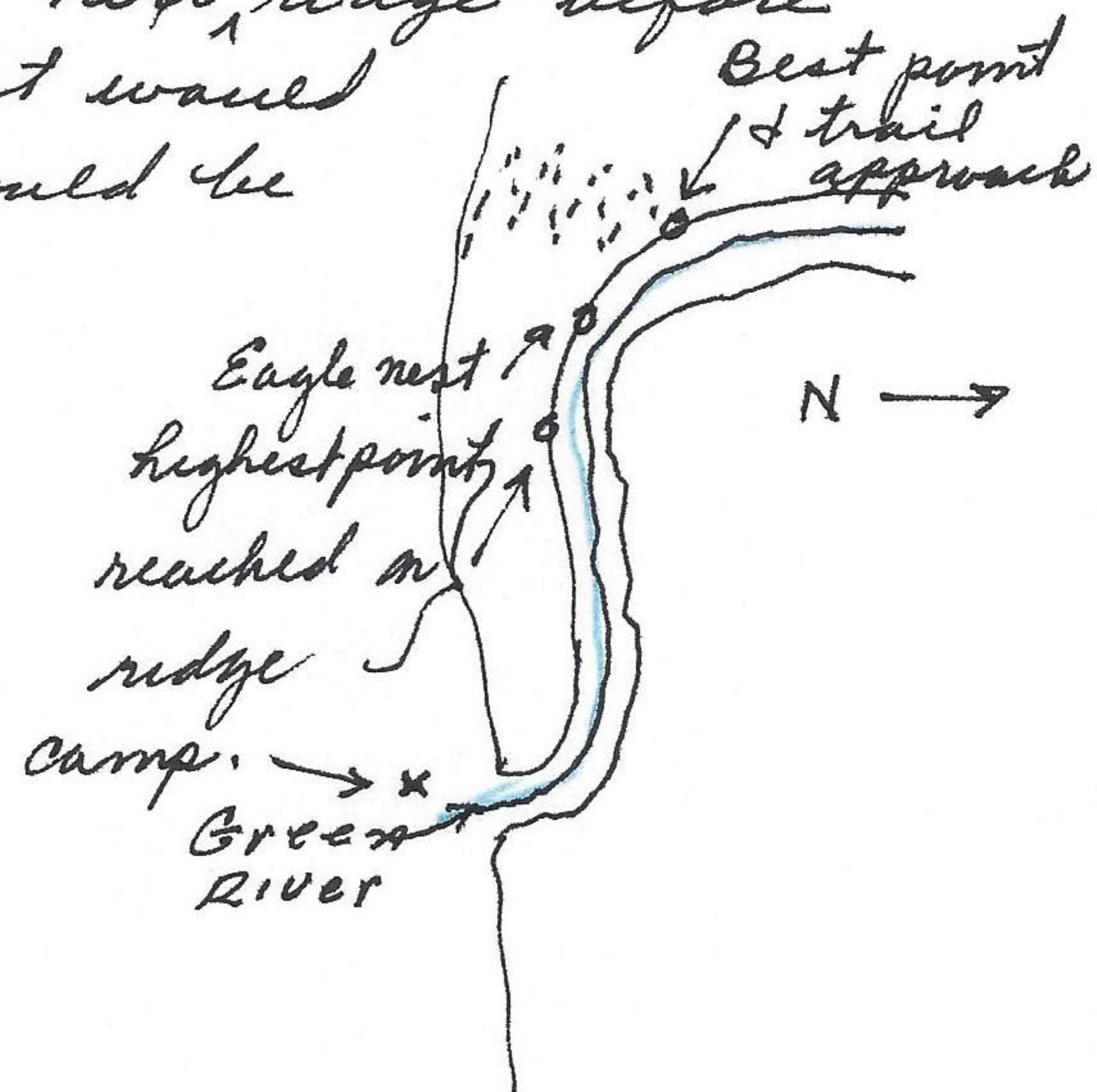


just below Duglesby Rapids. This is in fact the site of the nest (at bend to E) where they have a nest and the site that I will visit this A.M. Left base of ridge W of mouth of canyon at 8:30 A.M. At base of ridge observed Bullack oriole, 15 violet green swallows, 10 Brewer blackbirds, 1 magpie, 1 Eutamias minimus and a cottontail. Continued up ridge to flat area. a mourning dove left resting area at base of juniper. an ash-throated flycatcher among the juniper of flat. As I left the flat part of ridge I encountered the first white-throated swift. None observed 6 Sceloporus and 3 Cremodophorus. The Cremodophorus has brown posterior part of body and tail of same color. Rock wren. Violet green swallow common on ridge. Continued to upper peak but could not see eagle nest because of nest ^{lateral} ridge before nest wall. The best advantage point would be beyond curve and best approach would be up slope from S. From upper part of ridge took photo 820602-1 to E of typical ridge form and kinds of flowers. Green River Canyon to left and rough country E of the mouth of Split Canyon. Photo 820602-2 to W of gold eagle nesting cliff in middle of photo to left beyond next lateral ridge.



Best vantage point on overhanging rock on ridge beyond (dark shadow below). ^{Left top ridge 10:20 A.M.} Green River below at bend where river turns E. Duglesby Rapids approx 2/10 mi up river to right. It is in this area of the bend of the river that the ranger observed 2 eagles yesterday. Photo 820602-3 to W from ridge. Mesquite & Shinarump in foreground just beyond canyon below. Chucker partridge called from below. Photo 820602-4 of ridge and associated rocks & flowers. To left is abrupt drop of several hundred feet to Green River below. Many beaver trails across sands and side of river to trees & shrubs. House of beaver on N side Canyon. Photo 820602-5 farther down ridge to E. showing Billy Cassidy's cabin? Area developed for garden and some water ditches shown. Only way to cabin is to ford river from S side. This structure should be stabilized. Pronghorn jump calling from this level of ridge. also young antelope
