The *Thermopsis* is in prime of its blossoming stage while *Iris* have just pasted their flowering period. Oak, *Symphoricarpos* and aspen line this creek meadow. R. naped Sapsucker flew up from trees and crossed road to willows
- 85.1 Beautiful aspens and good oak groves.
- 85.3 Ponderosa pine coming into picture as we descend this mountain, aspen and oak still dominant.
