

Recommendations:

1. Establish periodic inviolate beaches & dunes along watercourse for wildlife. To rest and feed, especially during migration time and for marine turtles etc and other marine animals and for people to observe from beyond the area by scopes & video.
2. Heavy fine for leaving bottles or any glass container on beach. Lesser fine for anything left on beach. Fine should be cleaning up beach. Education is the only solution.
3. Educate people to the need of taking home all materials taken onto the beaches such as garbage, litter and other kinds of debris. Trash can then would not be needed.
4. no permanent installations on beach such as picnic tables and shelters.
5. Divide multiple use in to compatible categories: picnics, swimming, physical activities; fishing; bird watching; etc. It is obvious that one cannot watch & study birds with dozen of people & dogs running or walking along the beach or cars and motorcycles racing up & down the beach like an afternoon on an Interstate. Padre Island National Seashore is a prime example of this uncompatability of such activity and watching of birds or wild life. Divide the beach according to compatible use. Cars & an ^{Sunday} afternoon of students crowding the beaches are not compatible.
6. Control use of beach for certain uses where seashore values are to be experienced by reservation.
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
