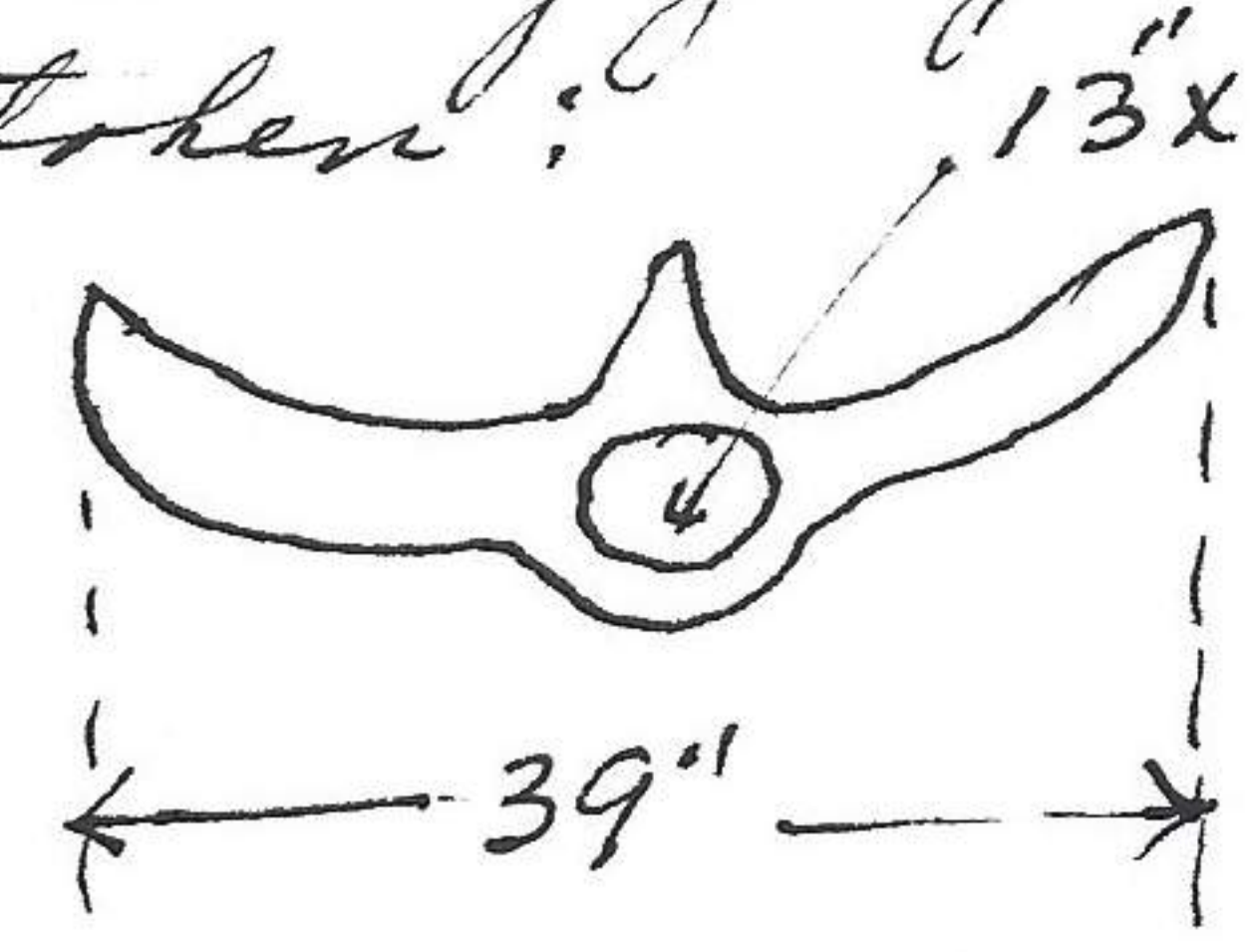
Harbor porpoise. *Phocaena phocaena*.

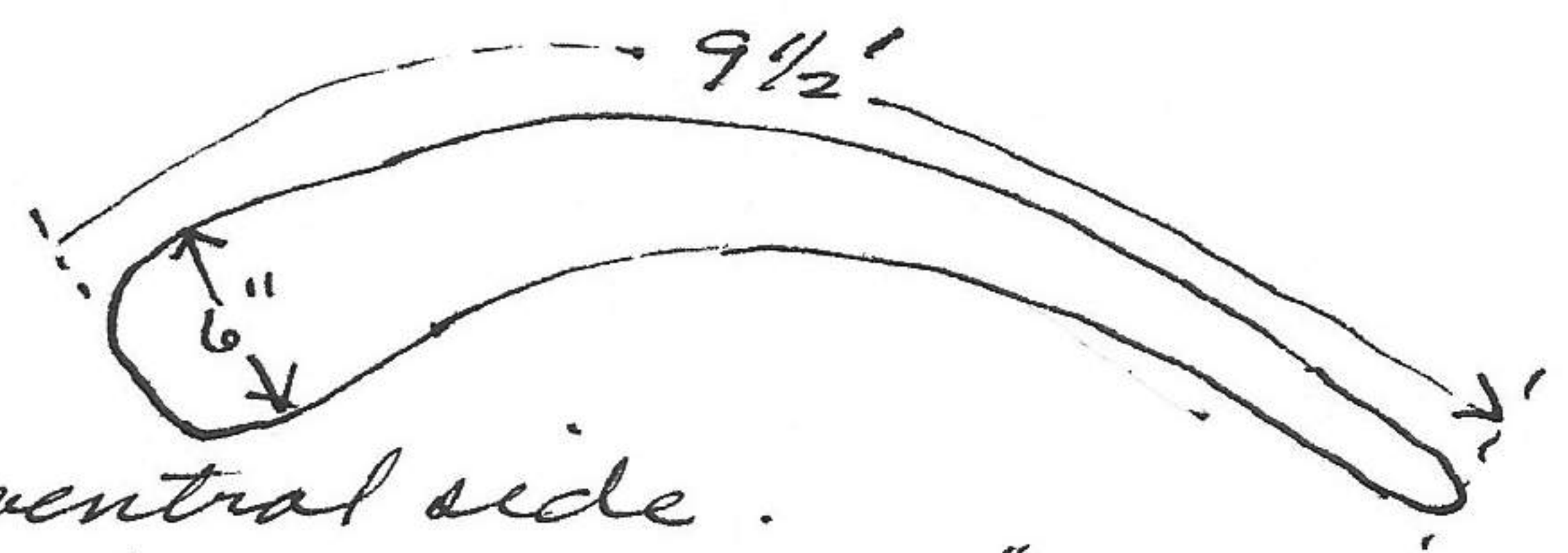
Several Calif. ground squirrels noted.

830623-1 vertebra of whale.



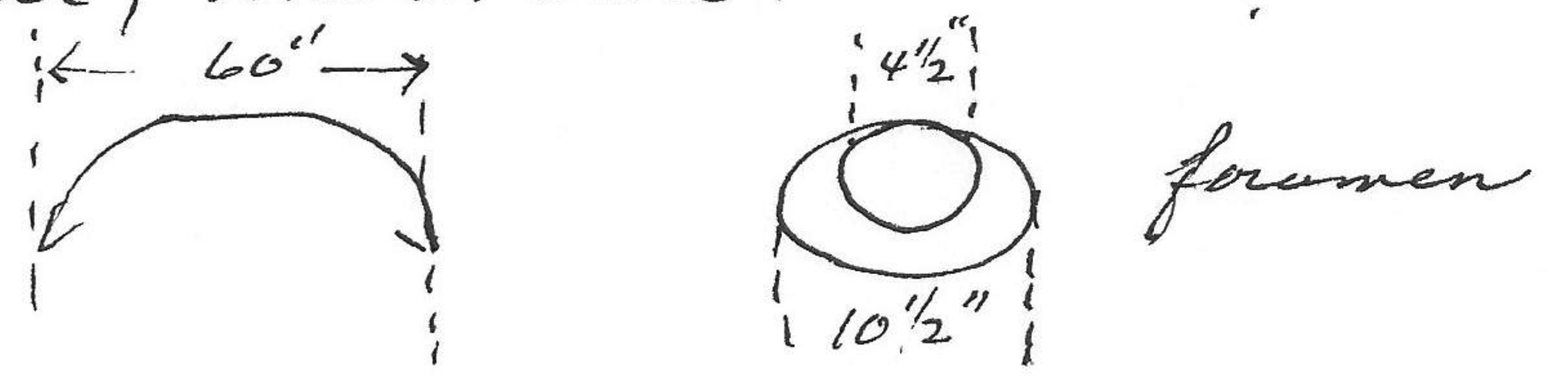
830623-2 general view of 2 ribs.



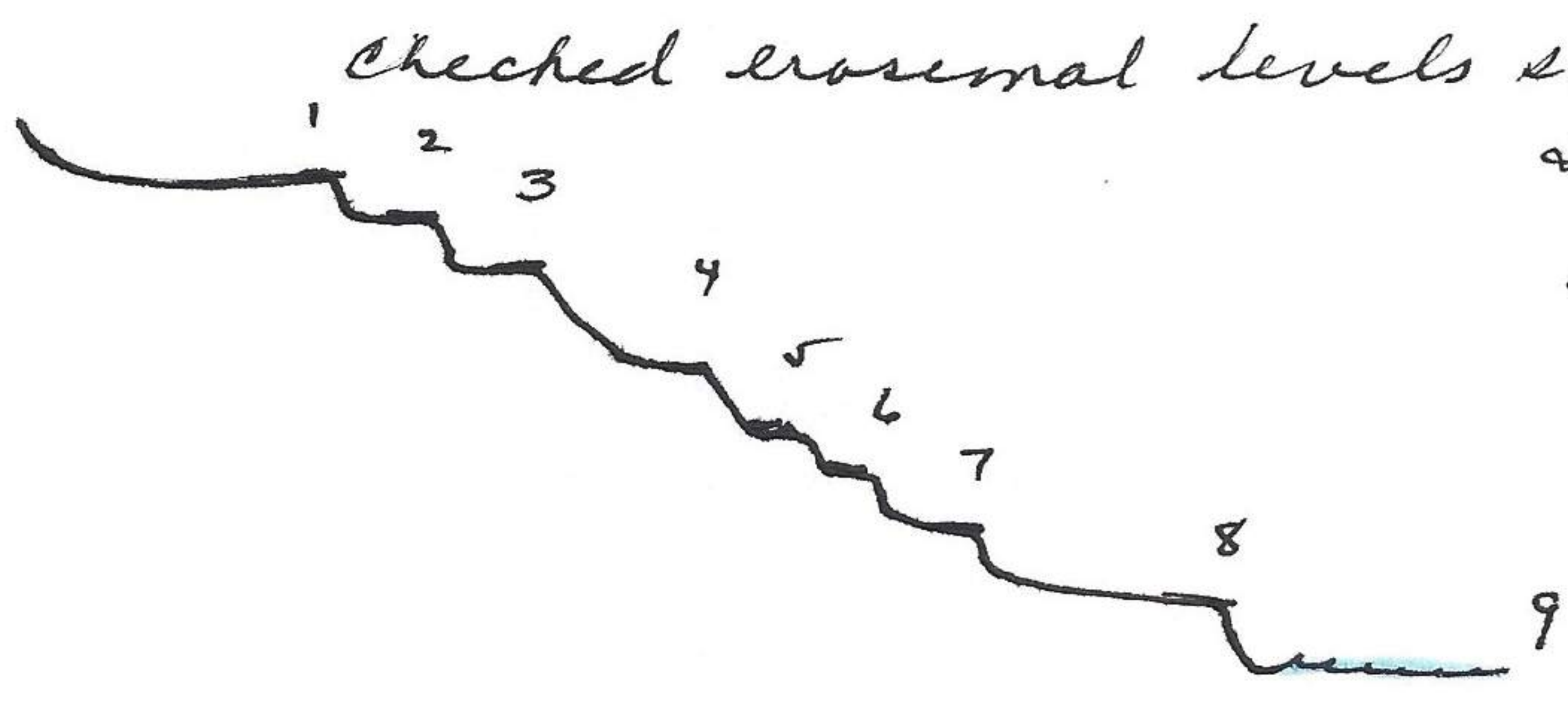
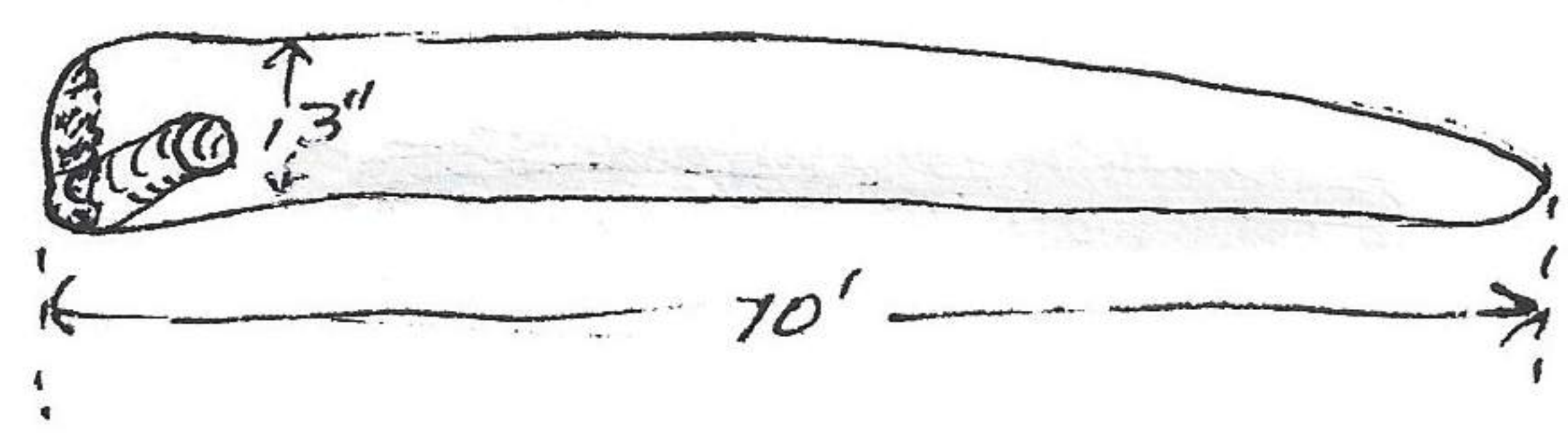
830623-3 proximal end rib
