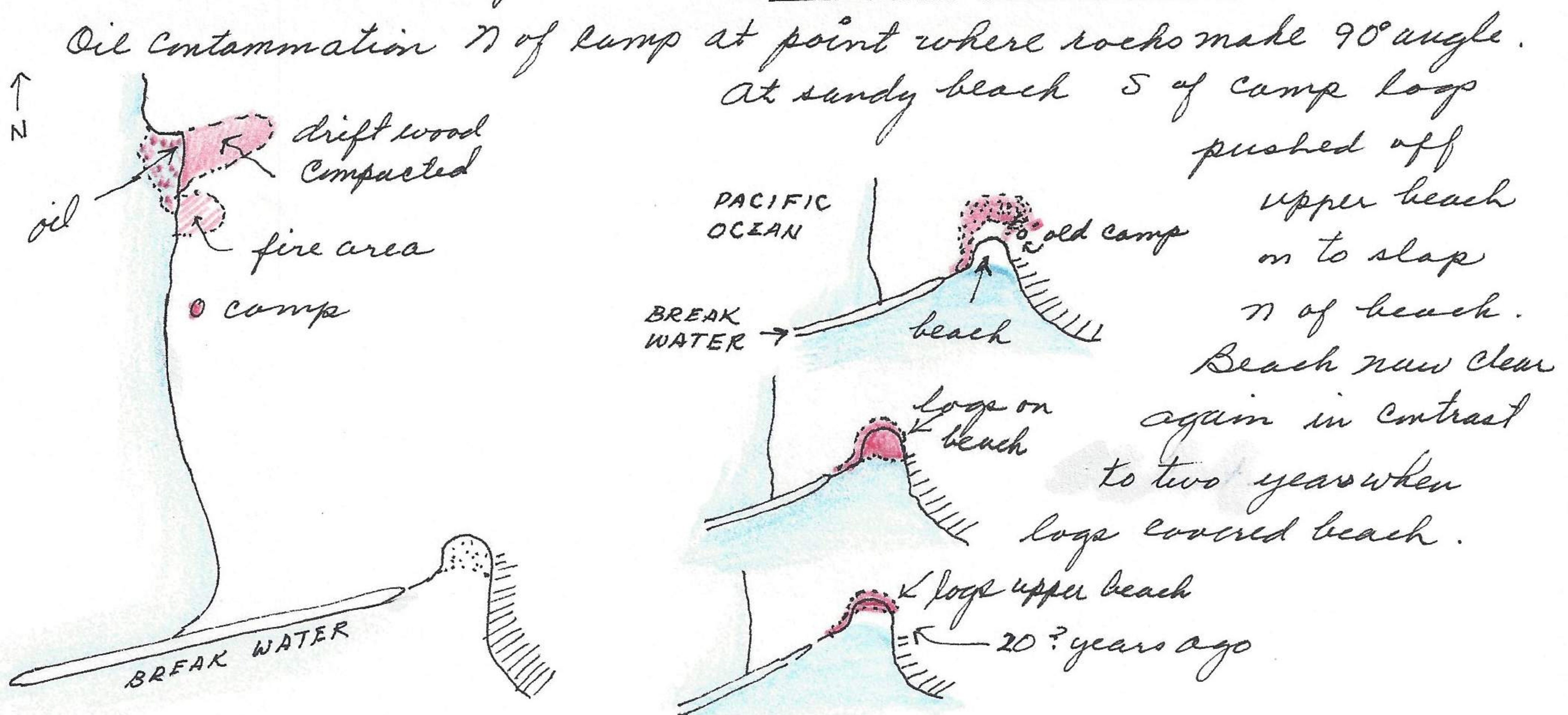


cormorant, Stellers jay, western grebe. mule deer tracks: 12, 15, 82, 87 mm.
also Townsend's chipmunk. Eutamias townsendi.



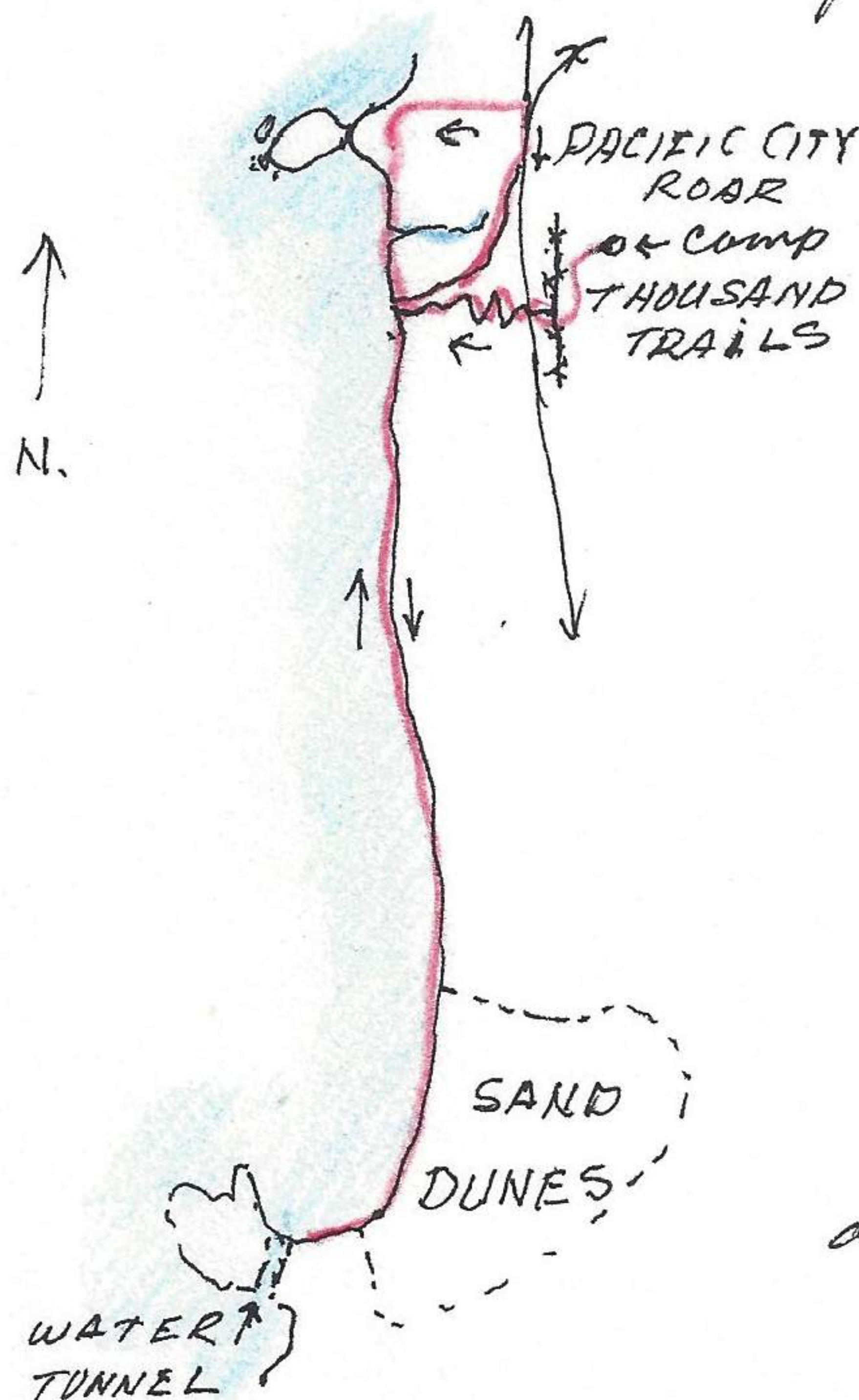
Left camp and drove to Pacific City (Thousand Trails) in Oregon. Sparrow hawk Seaside, Oregon. All raptors recorded on trip.

Nov. 1, 1984

min temp 44°F. Rain this A.M. Windy. Cloudy uniform. Rained all day and night.

Nov. 2, 1984

Rained all night, periodic high wind. min. temp. 52°F.
checked beach between point to N & S. Day rain, wind 40-50 MPR.
High tide to near land prominence. Between 8:30 A.M. to 11:15 A.M. Observed:



4 dead Cassin's auklets blown fresh with tide, one with broken leg in grass at entrance drainage from land, ^{flew to water,} all same size as those measured Oct 31 1984.

One canvas back duck in grass at high tide and just capable of flight.

1 dead cormorant.

2 dead black seaters.

Approx. 150 surf seaters not including a flock of 90 that flew S.

approx. 8 white-winged seaters

Dead black seater only one seen.
