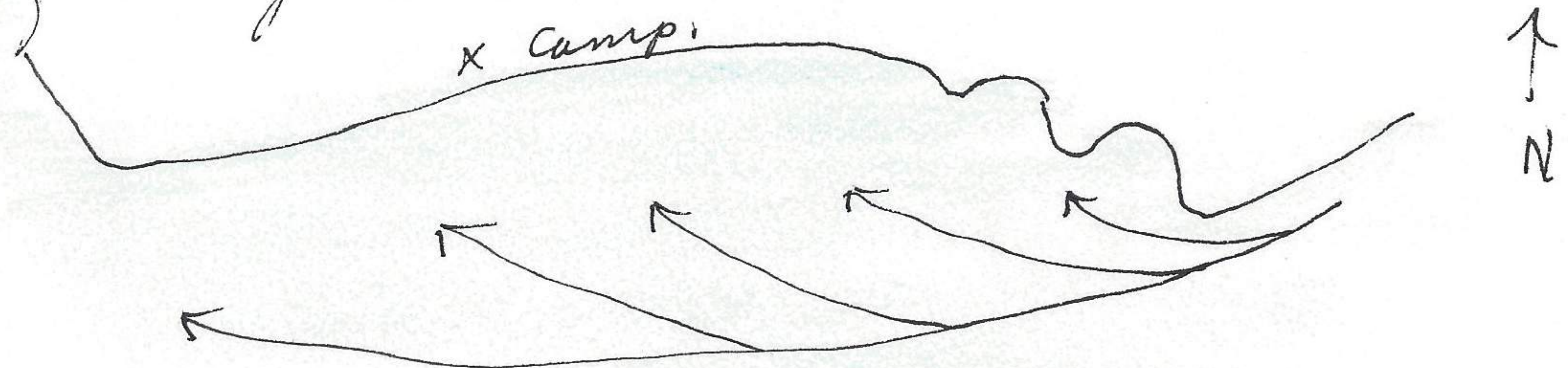


- 8:52 tide 17 1/2" currents near shore and elsewhere increasing in velocity. Great blue heron to W,
