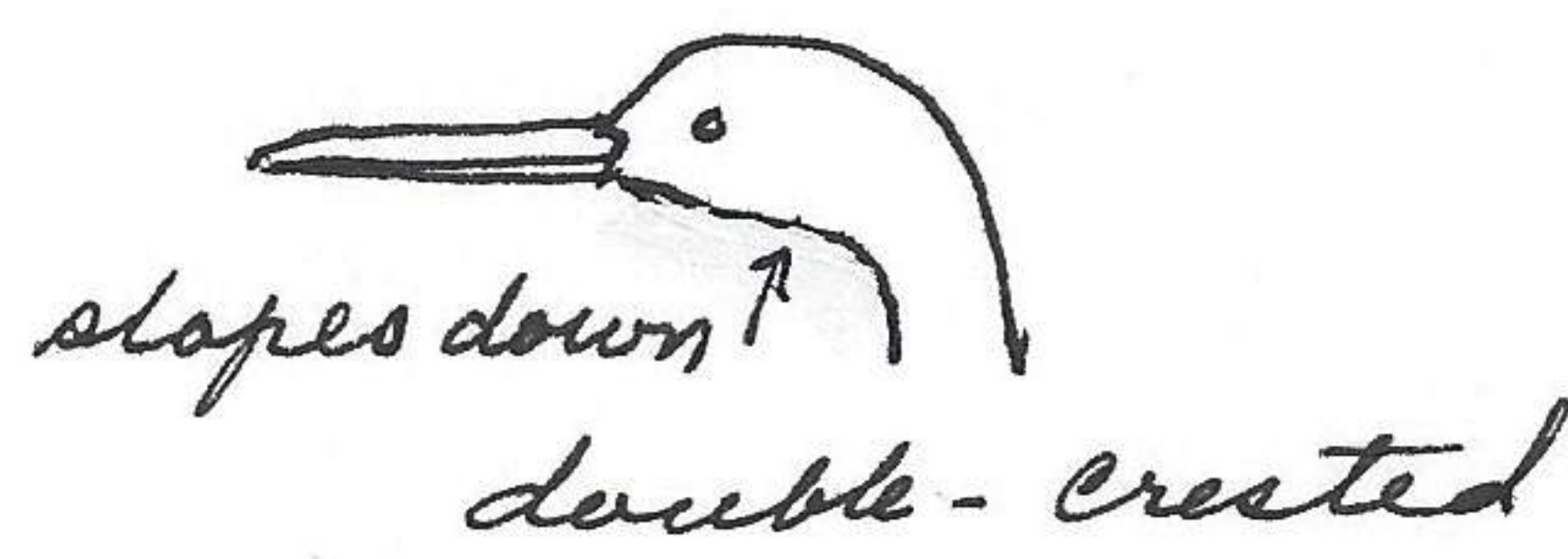
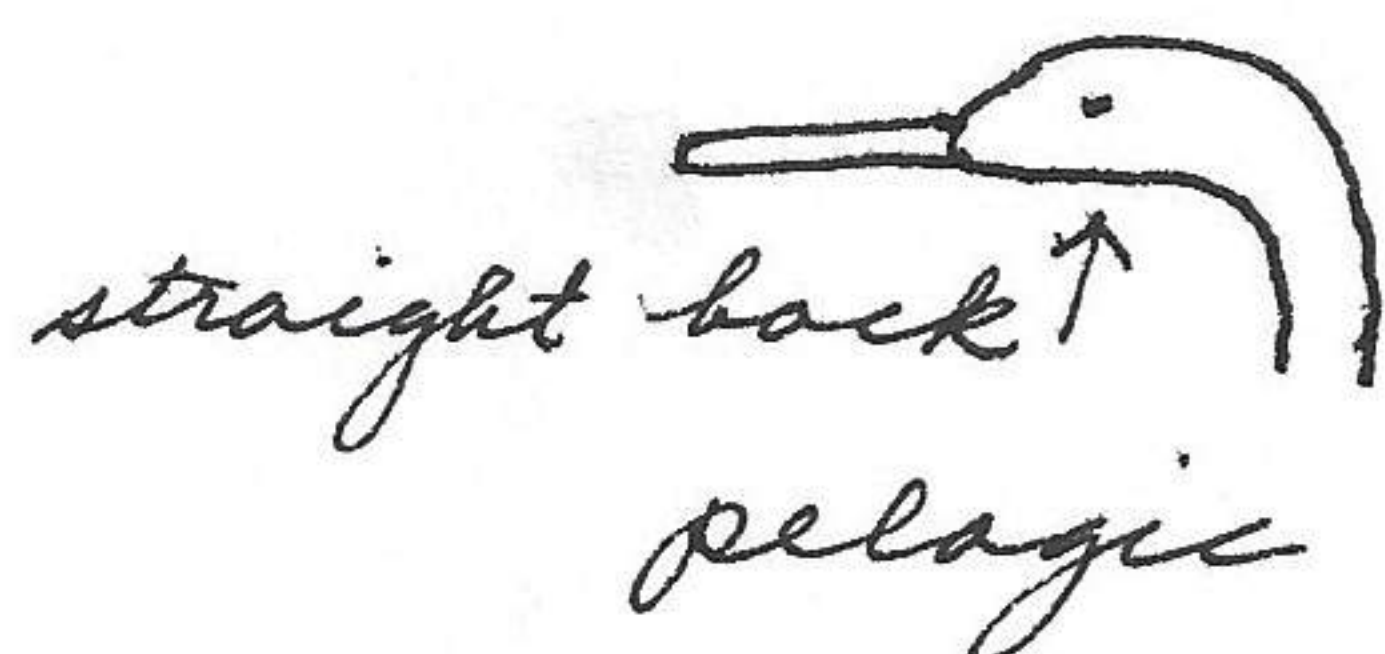


8:45 Common goldeneye submerged 26 sec. Horned grebe
36 and 38 seconds

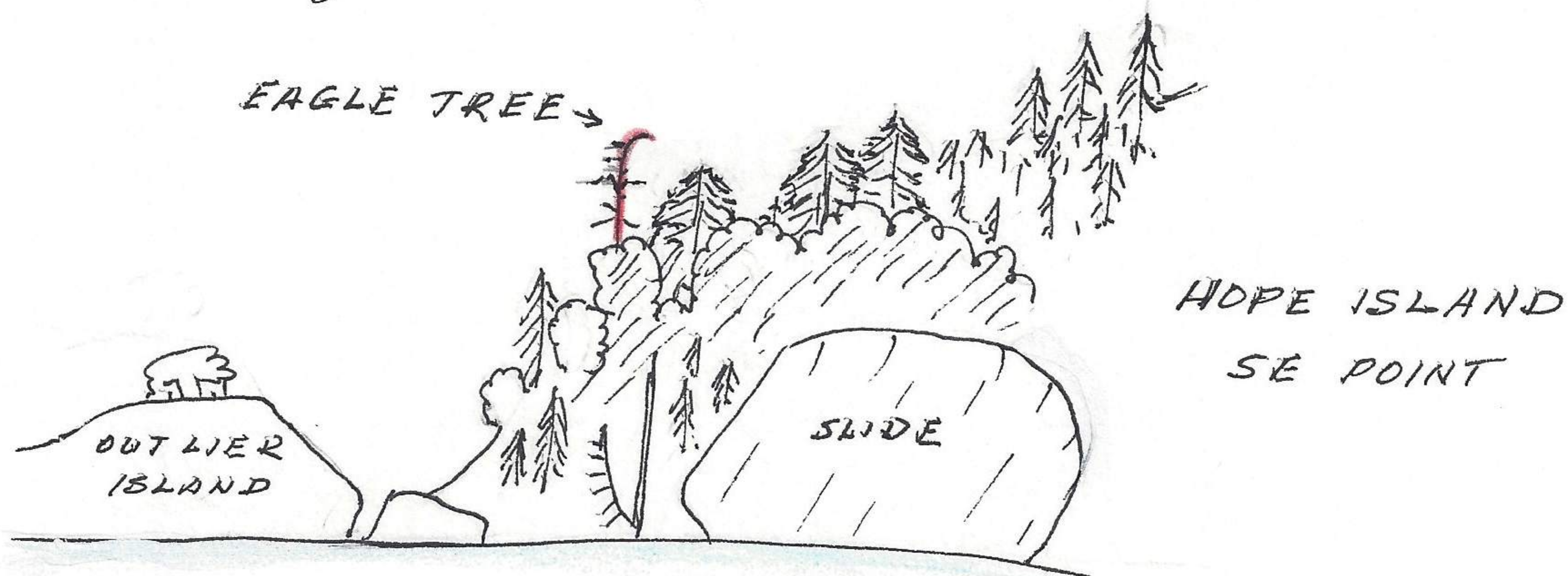
9:46 imm. bald eagle on SE end Hope Island.

An adult bald eagle displaced an immature bald eagle on above eagle tree on SE Point of Hope Island.

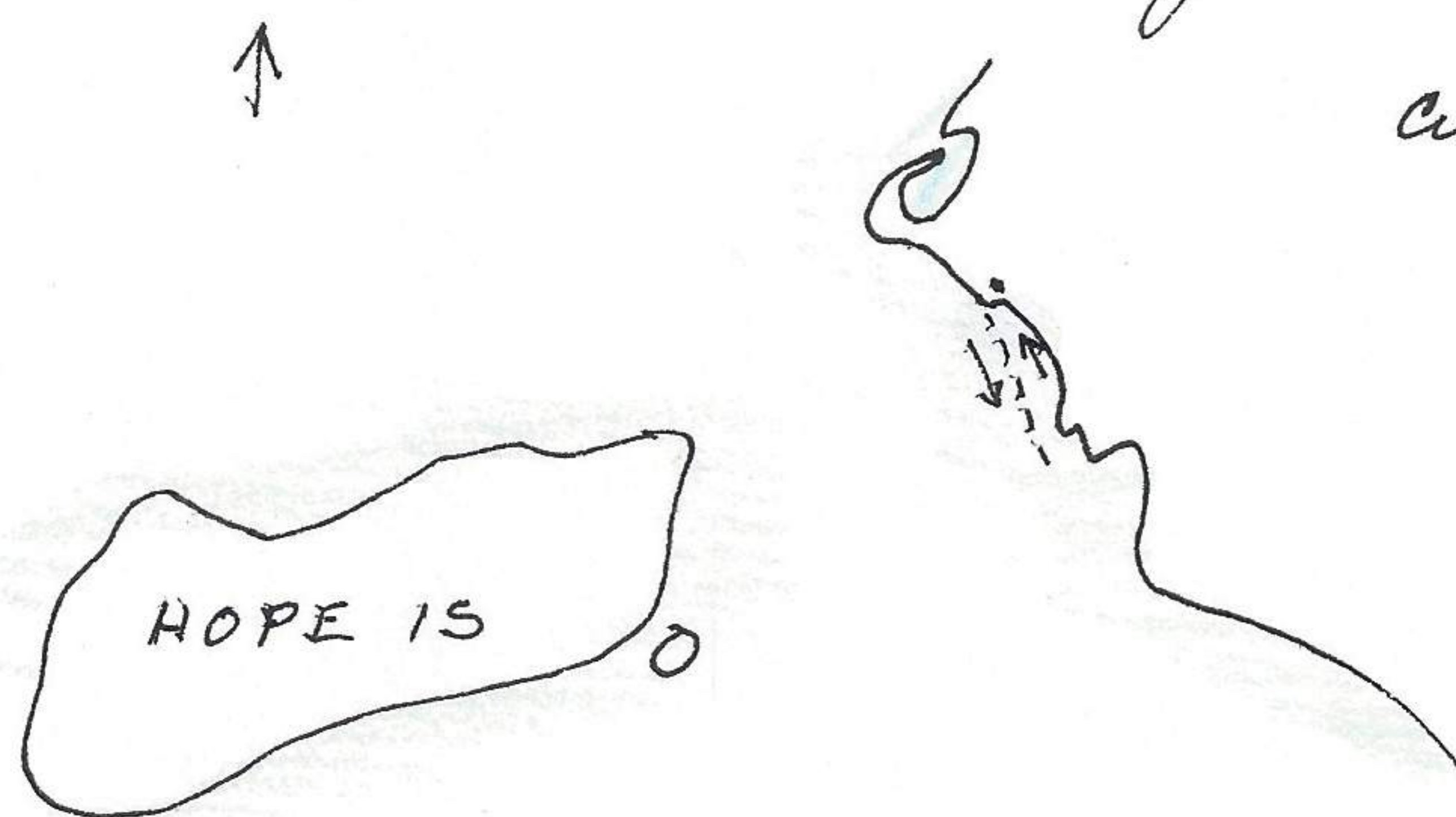
12:30 adult eagle above still on eagle tree.

12:31 logs passing back E but 1/4 distance near center of channel than when they passed ^W this A.M. at 8:00. Same average numbers of logs and some other debris

12:31 heard Canada geese pass overhead.

Horned grebe submerged (total submergence). 29 sec, 27, 26, 27, 26, 22, 23, 22, 36, 14, 22, 14. The two short periods were those when grebe brought to surface food.

12:40 "Horn Rock" being exposed (just very top) on ebb tide.
