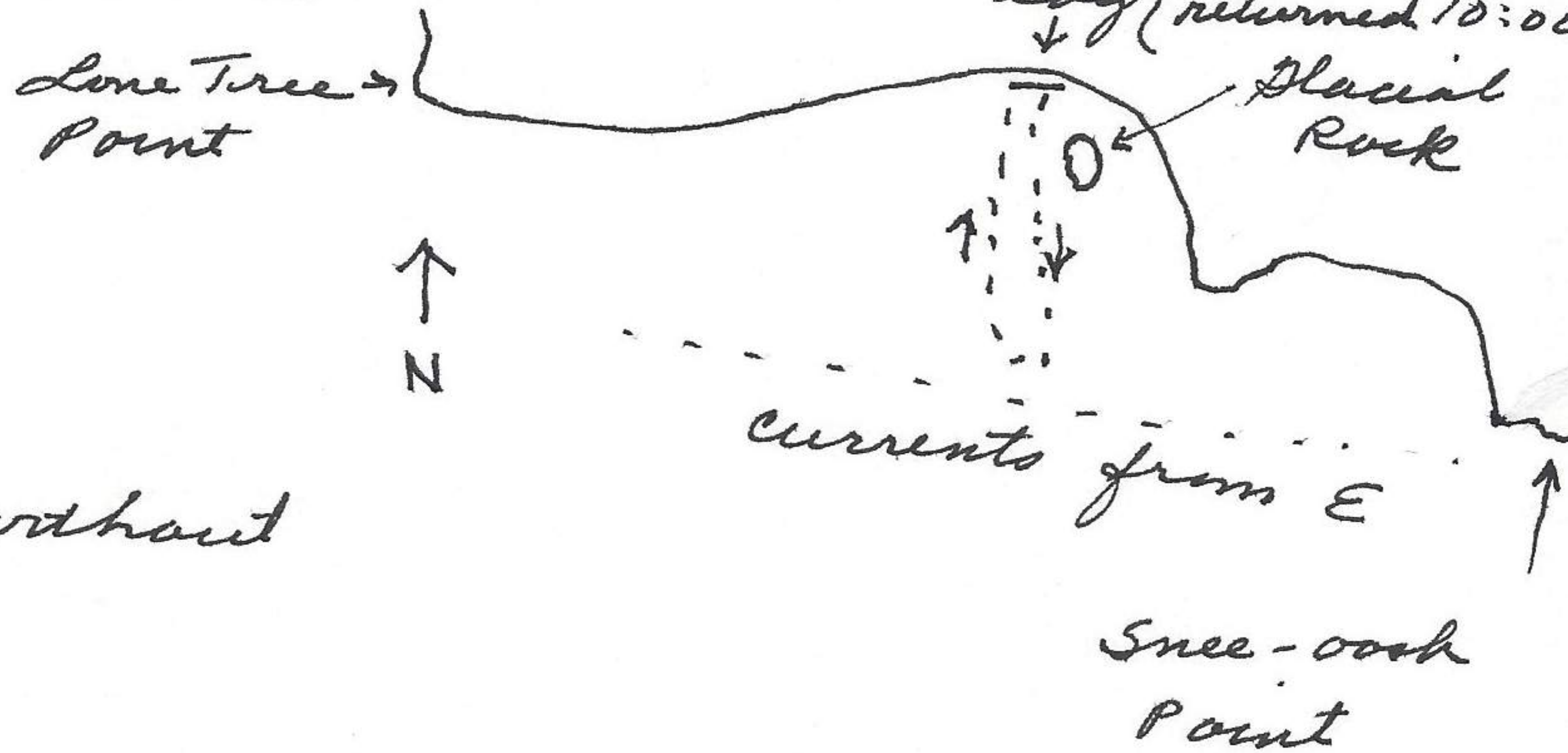


La Conner Preserve, (T.T.), Skagit Co., Washington.

Jan. 30, 1986

400 F at 8:00 A.M. no wind, some patches fog to S & W
9:45 a log lifted off shore at E end of T.T. property and slowly moved S, past (W side) Glacial Rock to currents moving W from Snee-oosh Point but; Unlike the previous movement of a log after Jan. 29, 1984, stopped and reversed its direction and returned N to shore.

Noted 2 new gulls riding log for 2/10 mi. They left and flew E above water in a direct straight course without deviation.



Left La Conner T.T. for Friday Harbor at 10:15 at mileage 97.9. Ferry at 10:40 at 11.6 miles or 13.7 miles from La Conner Preserve in 25 minutes.

Outside Friday Harbor approx. 30 new gulls in a dispersed group. Checked property SE turn with Coldwell Bankers. Also visited University of Washington Marine Laboratories. Met Dr. David O. Duggins who has done research in Glacier Bay in S.E. Alaska and now and worked with a student from K.U., the one who studied small mammals across straits S of Glacier Bay. He said that there are two houses on U. Wash. property on SW Shaw, one livable the other marginal and needs considerable work in refurbishing. Camp just N of Friday Harbor.

Jan. 31, 1986

checked bay S of Dawson Head on San Juan Island, thence coast road back to Friday Harbor, thence to Orcas Island. Drove to Deer Harbor to check property. At 900 yards S of Deer Harbor along bay photo:
