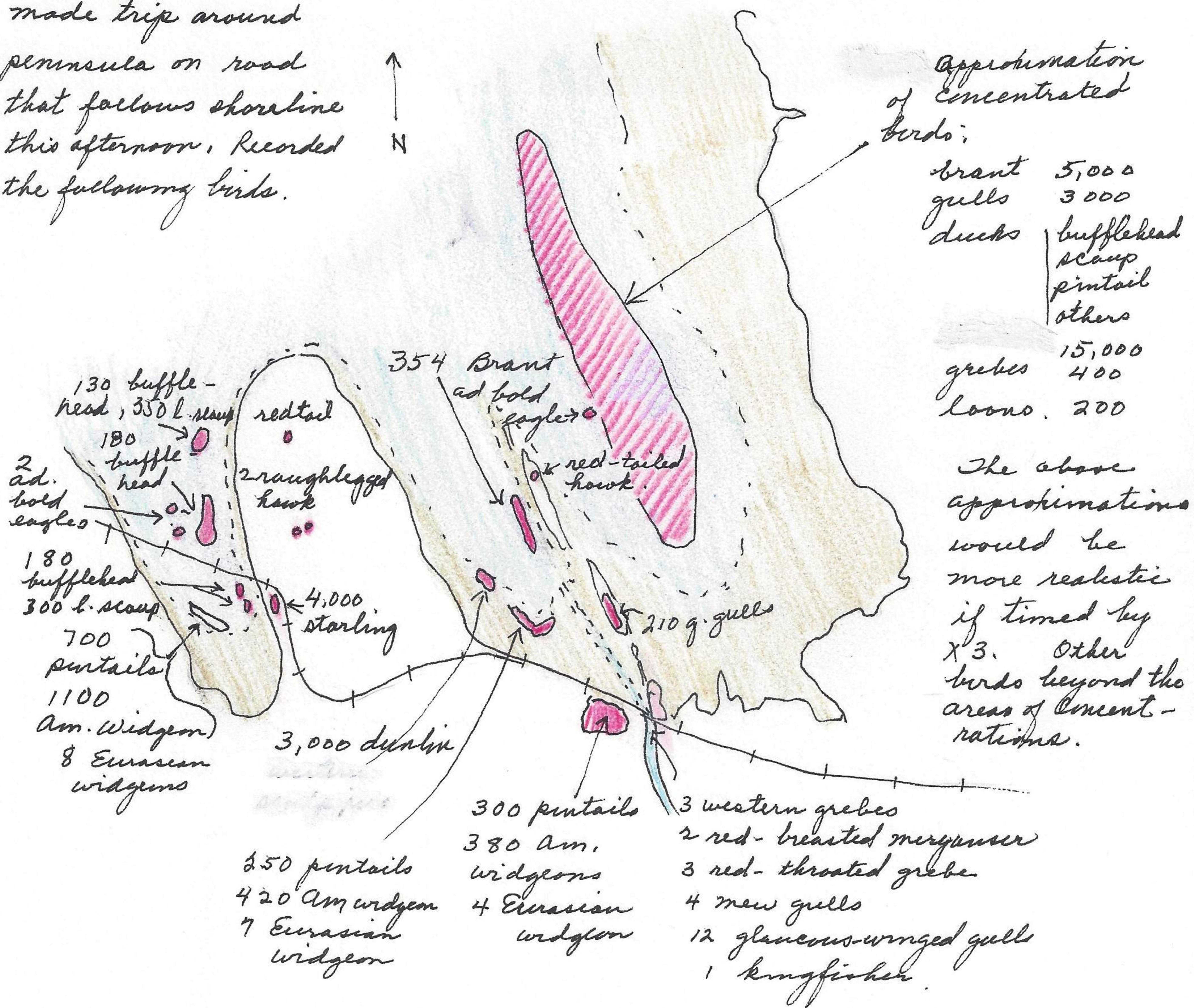


made trip around peninsula on road that follows shoreline this afternoon. Recorded the following birds.



The above approximations would be more realistic if timed by X3. Other birds beyond the areas of Concentrations.

At Anacortes (Suemas ferry terminal) observed the following birds:

- 30[♂] 7[♀] buffleheads
- 2 red-necked grebes
- 6 horned grebe
- 3 western grebe
- 5 scaup, lesser?
- 8 American Crow
- 2 red-breasted merganser
- 1 double-crested Cormorant
- 4 mew gulls
- 1 belted Kingfisher

Observed a glaucous-winged gull dive straight down 10' into and completely submerged in the water. It resurfaced in 2 seconds and had a live crab in its bill.
