

La Conner's Preserve, Thousand Trails, Spagit Co., Washington
 Feb. 21, 1986

Left La Conners Preserve for Lopez Island. at Anacortes ferry terminal noted 5 pelagic cormorant. near Leo Reef took photo 860221 of ^{over} house on Humphrey Head. Beyond were 8 pelagic cormorant on water. At Lopez terminal 3 pelagic cormorant on piling. A small gulllike bird on piling and about size of black-footed kittiwake. It was not a Bonaport gull.

at Odlin, ^{County} Park noted an adult bald eagle in tree, Enroute to Spencer Spit State Park, ^{1 mi. W} noted 23 robins in one group. At Spencer Spit were 3 immature bald eagles nesting just to W of spit. At convergence of Center and Hummel Lake roads 2 adult bald eagles. At Lopez Village one adult bald eagle. At Humphrey Head at Strandberg home 3 immature & 1 adult bald eagle flew by at not over 30' away (twice) Mrs. Joyce Fralic (neighbor to N) said that 3 eagles had been perching in trees just E of her home. She also said she feeds 16 gray squirrels and 2 raccoon. Deer eat her roses and other plants.

Hummel Lake frozen except west side (1/10 of lake). 8 buffleheads here. marsh N of lake frozen.

Lake SW of Swift Bay completely frozen.

At E end Spencer Spit 150 mew gulls and 8 glaucous-winged gulls. There was separation of species.

At first turn of road to W (Stanley Road) at old school house a red-tailed hawk glided down to a microtus, captured it and flew away; all within 20' of our vehicle.
