

Left Anacortes via ferry for Lopez Island. Usual birds including definite identification of the greater scaup. while at Lopez recorded periods of submergence of the pigeon guillemot as: 1'12", 1'4", 1'9", 1'13", 1'14", . It remained in top at 2'27"

Continued to Odlin County Park on Lopez Island for night. From camp at edge of large Douglas fir (just S of boat put-in, observed 16♀ and 4 ♂ greater scaup. Some of the drank salt water. They came to shore area from middle of channel and fed in close formation in one area and then would swim to another area along near shore (150') without feeding along the way.

Eight buffleheads fed 100 or so feet from shore, generally in pairs.

1 greater scaup
