

6:25 A.M. ad. bald eagle to N.

6:35 A.M. first glaucous-winged gull to N. Imm. bald eagle to S. 

7:00 sun 3 diameter above ridge Blakely Is. 

7:10 11 mew gulls flew N and nat in feeding pattern,

This afternoon purchased material for hand rail on steps.

Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Wash.
march 10, 1986

A log in water (6'x12') from at least 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. from 6" feet out to contact with shore. It remained in same area +/- 10 feet.

11:20 above log moved W 20'. but still along shore.

march 11, 1986 ♂

In cattails N of Hummel Lake 5 red-wing blackbirds on territories. On march 1 only one was present. One individual always observed in same area of cattails, 1 Coot.

at Swift Lake observed 1 shrike (same area for last 4 days; 7 gadwalls,

at marsh SE old school house on Port Stanley Road were 1 marsh hawk, 8 mallards, 6 green-winged teal, 11 pintails, 14 shovellers, 164 american widgeon.

at Hummel Lake were 161 common mergansers at S side of lake, 8 bufflehead general distributed and in pairs,

march 12, 1986

at marsh SE old school house on Stanley Port Road noted 18 mallards, 3 green-winged teal, 18 pintails, 11 shovellers and approx 150 American widgeons.

march 13, 1986

Immature bald eagle passed Bee Lodge going S at daybreak. Glaucous-winged gull a few minutes (10) after followed by mew gulls approx 1/2 hr. later.

254 surf scoters approx 1/10 mi. SE of Leo Reef.

Adult bald eagle perched on beam light on Leo Reef from 6:50 A.M. to 7:20 A.M.

Counted 153 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island. They were generally distributed.

8:10 A.M. 2 harbor seals on Leo Reef (No. 3)
