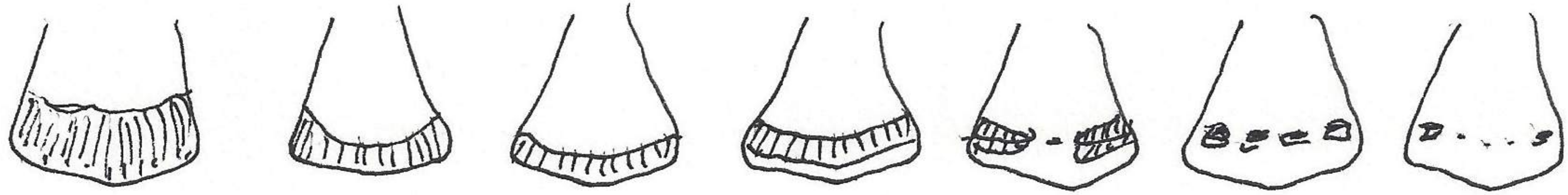


1:00 P.M. 10 ♂ and 7 ♀ purple finch.
 4 eastern grey squirrels at ^{porch} feeder. bobtail, broken tail, red scapula and normal scapula.

March 14, 1986

Same number of glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island as observed yesterday, 8:00 A.M.

This A.M. 3 adult & 2 imm. bald eagles flew by Bee House.
 Observed tail patterns of mew gulls.



noted a glaucous-winged gull to descend at a 30°-40° angle at great speed from approx. 400' to within 20' of water.

2 ravens flew high across sound to E, calling.

15 ♂ & 21 ♀ purple finches at ^{porch} feeder. When a finch is stressed it moves away sideways. Group of finches left 9:20 A.M. and returned 9:30 A.M.

On trip to Lopez Village at Swift Bay beach noted:

85 glaucous gulls.

18 mew gulls

2 black oystercatchers

8 huffle heads

4 common goldeneye

3 greater yellowlegs

at Swift Lagoon adjoining bay

3 greater yellowlegs

8 gadwall.

At Humphrey Lagoon, Humphrey Head noted 8 hufflehead, half moles, and one glaucous gull.

measure distance to ferry from home. 3362 Humphrey Head at 2.3 miles. On ferry to Friday Harbor noted 3 common murre, 4 pigeon guillemots, 13 pelagic cormorants, 15 gulls sp.?, 2 common loons (backs already developing checkerboard pattern).

On return to Lopez Island made trip to Richardson at South End. at Swift Bay noted 18 mew gulls, 1 great blue heron, 19 gulls sp. 4 double-crested cormorants.

at a marsh near Richardson noted:

35 greenwing teal, 10 pintails, 2 mallards.
