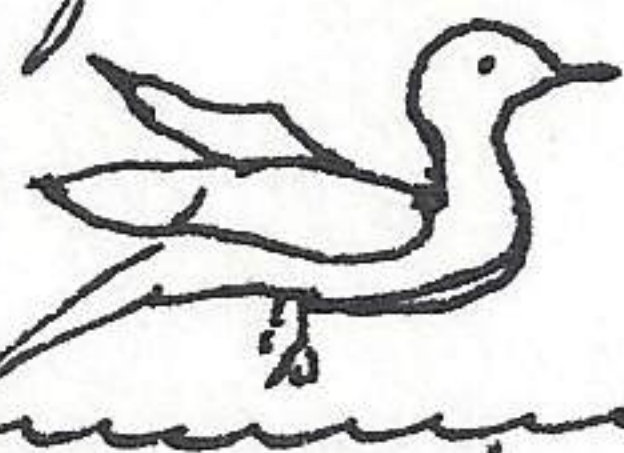


during rain 22 mew gulls and 6 Bonaparte gulls fished for candlefish minnows. They strike a dove-like pose when fluttering and moving just above water; head and neck up-right.



After rain at 11:30 seals (harbor) left Leo Reef. The distribution on reef 2(5), 3(7), 4(9), 5(6).

Townsend chipmunk fed during rain.

"Shanoo" Wn 26395 of Shelter Bay anchored at Leo Reef for 3 hours of diving. Spend 1 hr below.

Immature bald eagle circled Leo Reef (1:30 P.M.) and then flew W to tree on point south of Spring Cove.

1:30 P.M. 28 mew gulls resting on Leo Reef and same group that fished the waters between house & reef this A.M.

4:30 28 white-winged scoters.

March 24, 1986

worked on driveway

March 25, 1986

mew gulls fished between house and Leo Reef between 7:15 and 8:30 A.M. They will all leave together, then later return.

Oregon junco stood off challenge of house finch.

March 26, 1986

Red-tailed hawk in open field N of Lopez Village.

Rain all afternoon

5:45^{P.M.} otter (river) at 3362 Humphrey Head at home, (Bee Estate) white-caps onto upper bank at house.

6:35 P.M. gray squirrel feeding at this late time approaching dusk.

High wind and waves, hard on rocks below when purple finch and pine siskin leave feeding area at our house they out over water then upward at graduated levels to height of ridge rather than up or down water level.

March 27, 1986

This afternoon observed one large mule deer (♂?), 2 adult females and 2 young of last year. The fed in Deer Trail Slope and then at dusk left via SE side Bee House, across steep rock
