

Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Washington  
 April 1, 1986

7:20 A.M. immature eagle flew by Bee House along shoreline 20' above water and continued to S.

8:00 A.M. Ebb tide. Harbor seal on Leo Reef. W. grebe in water near seal.

8:30 A.M. 5 harbor seal on Leo Reef although rock still covered with water. One harbor seal displaced 11 glaucous-winged gulls as it left water and gained top of rock where they were standing, Rock # 5.

9:10 A.M. 9 harbor seal on rock of Leo Reef. Also a river otter on number 3 rock eating its catch.

9:20 A.M. 9 harbor seal on rocks of Leo Reef. A glaucous-winged gull stood 1 foot from side of <sup>one</sup> seal.

9:22 A.M. Eastern gray squirrel with split ear arrived at porch feeder.

9:30 A.M. 11 harbor seal on Leo Reef (when <sup>name</sup> Leo Reef is used alone it refers to one or all the rocks 1 to 7.)

10:50 A.M. 14 harbor seal on Leo Reef.

Noted gulls riding on fishing vessels.

Heard call of Common crow that is lower in pitch and if one could call it, sympathetically in tone.

11:00 A.M. immature bald eagle passed Bee House 30' above shoreline and alighted in top Douglas Fir tree above Lichen Point

Pelagic Cormorant have conspicuous white patches on sides of rump.

Observed mew gulls 'walk' on water as they fished in flight, some as far as 5 feet.

11:30 A.M. all harbor seal off Leo Reef.

12:00 P.M. family of deer at deer feeder.

12:08 P.M. House finch ♂ displaces purple finch, ♀ occasionally will displace purple finch.

12:30 P.M. harbor seal on Leo Reef and remains although half in water

12:31 36 birds at porch feeder, 5 pine siskin; 2 house finch, 29 purple finch (13 ♂ - 16 ♀), also 2 Townsend chipmunks and 2 eastern gray squirrels.

10:00 P.M. Raccoon at porch feeder for first time.
