5:45 P.M. a ♂ & ♀ hooded merganser fed in Spring Cove.

April 7, 1986

7:15 A.M. a band-tailed pigeon fed at porch feeder and another joined at 7:30 A.M. and left 1 minute later. The first one fed until 7:45 A.M.

no harbor seal on Leo Reef today.

Two ♀ and 2 ♂ red-breasted mergansers fed in Spring Cove.

Two sightings of immature bald eagles today.

5:30 P.M. Band-tailed pigeon at porch feeder. Sun had already left area.

Purple finch alight on feeder with band-tailed pigeon but are wary about the pigeons.

Usual birds ^{and mammals} at feeder are: purple finch, house finch, pine siskin, song sparrow, common crow, band-tailed pigeon, Townsend chipmunk, eastern gray squirrel.

6:05 band-tailed pigeons generally leave when disturbed by man. One left feeder this evening on own accord.

Townsend chipmunk fed 2 feet from band-tailed pigeon.

April 8, 1986

♂ house finch at porch feeder with 1/2 x 1/4 sq inches of albinism on upper scapula area.

9:00 A.M. a band-tailed pigeon at feeder for 15 minutes. a second pigeon arrived 5 minutes after first one arrived and fed together. most small birds leave when pigeons arrive.
