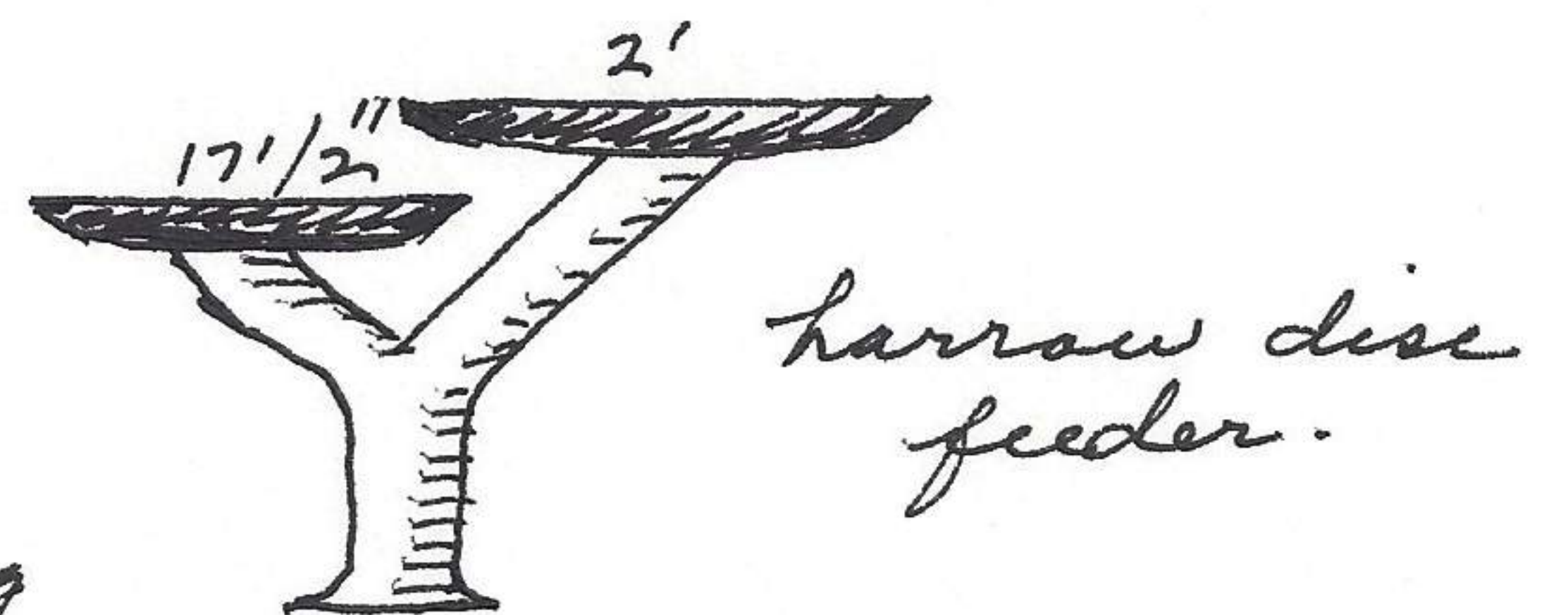

Pine siskin stand off purple finch

1:00 P.M. Birds at porch feeder. 16 ♂, 22 ♀, purple finch; 1 dark-eyed juncos; 30 pine siskin, 1 ♂, 1 ♀, house finch. (The porch feeder consists of a "railing trough 13 feet long and a 2 foot ^{diameter} x 2" deep metal harrow disc with a 17 1/2 diameter harrow ^{disc} beneath.

Porch feeder has reference to both rail & harrow disc feeders.)

1:10 P.M. 30 birds fed on top disc of harrow disc feeder including 11 pine siskin, 19 purple finch.
