1:36 P.M. 3 harbor seal on Leo Reef.

1:38 P.M. 2 common mergansers diving 30' out from shoreline from Bee House (SE).

5:55 P.M. 3 Bonaparte gulls, one followed a fishing boat for 200'

April 10, 1986

Before sunrise 1 common loon, 2 double-crested cormorants

After sunrise 1 common loon, no gulls.

Day clear but clouds on mainland to E. water smooth.

4:00 P.M. 1916 School House. 2 mallards.

Swift Lagoon. 12 gadwalls, 4 buffleheads, 18
glaucous-winged gulls.

Hummel Lake. 8 buffleheads and 18 unidentified
ducks.

April 11, 1986

Before sunrise 1 common loon, 1 western grebe.

After sunrise 1 " " , 2 glaucous-winged gulls,
5 Bonaparte gulls.

From sunrise to 10:00 A.M. 11 Bonaparte gulls fed on candle-
fish out from Spring Cove. Wind
blowing and the gulls glided most
of the time with wings out + up.
They would contact water with feet
from gliding position and sometimes
hop from wave to wave. Because
of wind they moved slow with head
up and above a fish would flutter forward but
