7:20 A.M. male & female (pairs?) leave feeding area together.

185 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island.

Trip to Richardson. At 1 mi. S of High School noted a Turkey vulture. 183 american widgeon generally distributed in grass of field.

at Swift Lagoon 10 gadwalls

Shark Reef mule deer tracks measuring 55, 66, 35 mm.

Humphrey Head Lagoon 8 pairs buffleheads.

Hummel Lake. 1 canvas back, 4 pro scamp, 12 pairs bufflehead, 36 northern tree sparrows.

Started humming bird feeder.

7:21 A.M. 2 rhinoceros auklets

7:22 A.M. immature bald eagle flew W across Lopez Sound to S end of Humphrey Head.

110 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island. from shore

7:30 A.M. river otter swam S in front Bee House. (out 10')

3:00 P.M. Enroute ^{Lopez} Village

Swift Lagoon. 9 gadwalls, 1 greater yellowlegs.

3:01 no harbor seal on Leo Reef as of this time.

April 16, 1986

wind all night from SE. Between 6:30 A.M. and 7:15 A.M. ^{90% of} glaucous-winged gulls sailed S.

7:20 Gray squirrel eastern, and purple finch fed on 24" harrow disc spaced 1' apart. Pine siskin fed closer to squirrels at 8" apart.

This A.M. to 10:00 A.M. 10 sightings of bald eagle, 4 in view at one time.

10:05 one minute after eastern gray squirrel left disc feeder 32 birds came to ^{same} feeder, 20 purple finch and 12 pine siskins.
