

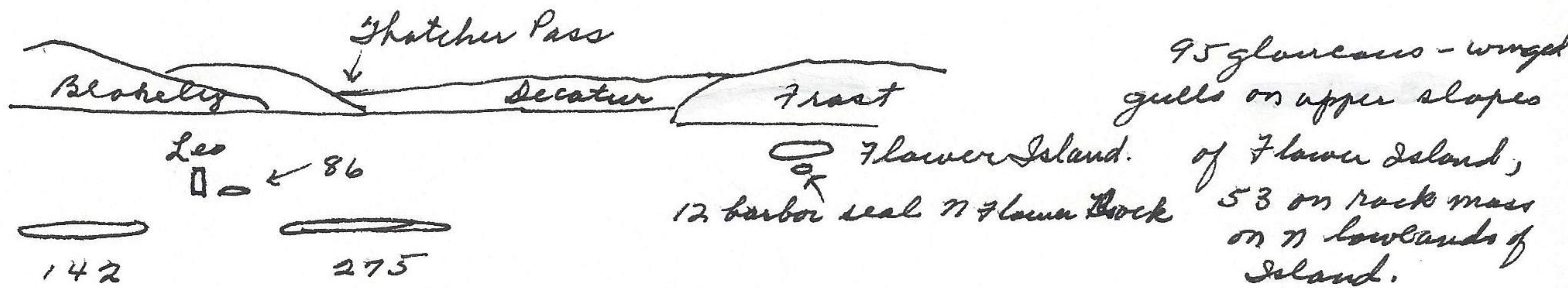
Leo Reef, 128 Bonaparte gulls, 4 glaucous and 2 harbor seal swimming around the reef.

a glaucous-winged gull displaced Bonaparte gulls as it walked thru resting Bonaparte gulls.

There has never been more than 2 eastern gray squirrels on the 24' harrow disc feeder on front porch.

The house finch has relatively smaller head to body than purple finch, stands more erect and hops like an English sparrow
Townsend chipmunk 10 inches from house and purple finches on harrow disc (24" diameter)

2:50 P.M. clear and sunny.



2 rafts of feeding or resting Bonaparte gulls and on group on Leo Reef, totaling 503 birds

76 white-fronted geese flew S

April 22, 1986

3:20 P.M. 120 white-fronted geese flew S.

April 23, 1986

clear, cumulus clouds to E, dark clouds to N.

5:30 A.M. 153 glaucous-winged gulls on upper slopes of Flower Island and 76 on rocks on lowlands N-end island.

5:40 A.M. 87 Bonaparte gulls and 3 glaucous-winged gulls resting on Leo Reef, one raft NE of Leo Reef of 26 Bonaparte gulls and one raft (long line) of 42 Bonaparte gulls NW Leo Reef. no harbor seal on reef.

5:56 AM sun 20 minutes above mt. tops and lighting tops of cumulus clouds.

6:06 AM 8 Bonaparte gulls on Leo Reef and 48 flying in general area feeding. 2 rhinoceros auklets in area SW of Bee House. They dive with a quick flip as if evading an aerial predator. They also produce a spout of water in the process of diving.

6:45 A.M. 160 Bonaparte gulls on Leo Reef and immediate surrounding waters.
