3:35 P.M. first time song sparrow at feeder but they have been in general area.

6:40 P.M. first pileated woodpecker in Douglas fir on S side Lower Parking Lot, called 3 times, has goshawklike call.

8:56 Lights fading and visibility barely possible, but sufficient to count white gulls (glaucous-winged gulls).

Top Flower Island 115; rocky area N end island 60 and others coming in.

April 29, 1986

Clear, cumulus to E.

5:30 A.M. Glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island;

Top 153; rocks on N end island 76

5:35 A.M. Leo Reef 87 Bonapartes, no harbor seals.

5:56 A.M. Sun about 20 min above Blakely Island, and above cumulus clouds.

In last 2 days two flocks of white-fronted geese flew N. one of a flock of 120, the other 76 (3:10 P.M.).

6:06 A.M. 8 Bonaparte gulls on Leo Reef, 48 flying in general area.

6:20 A.M. 2 rhinoceros auklets dove in front Bee House and each produced spout of water when diving

12:20 P.M. 52 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island (top) and 30 on rocks N end.

12:30 28 harbor seal on N Flower Rock.

4 " " " Leo Reef, no gulls.

April 30, 1986

6:52 A.M. 115 glaucous-winged gulls on Flower Island on top, 80 on rocks north end.

10:25 A.M. 8 black oystercatchers on Leo Reef.
