

Humphrey Lake. no birds. From here to beach - angle worm trails in mud of road.

Swift High Bank Beach. white-crowned sparrow, ♂♀ brown-headed cowbird, song sparrow, starling.

Plummers Promontory to home - robin.

At Bee House 8 band-tailed pigeons at feeder, 14 brown-headed cowbirds (3♀, 11♂), courtship, heads up by both sexes.

A pine siskin fluttered before a purple finch but without success.

First seasonal appearance^{of} cowbirds occurred as singles now and in last 3 days in groups of 8-14.

Townsend chipmunks are the first and last individuals to feed at feeder.

Originally purple finch dominate pine siskin but on a few occasions recently the dominance has been reversed.

Refous humming birds ♂'s at feeder at least to 8:55 P.M. when time approaching dusk. Some light in west.
