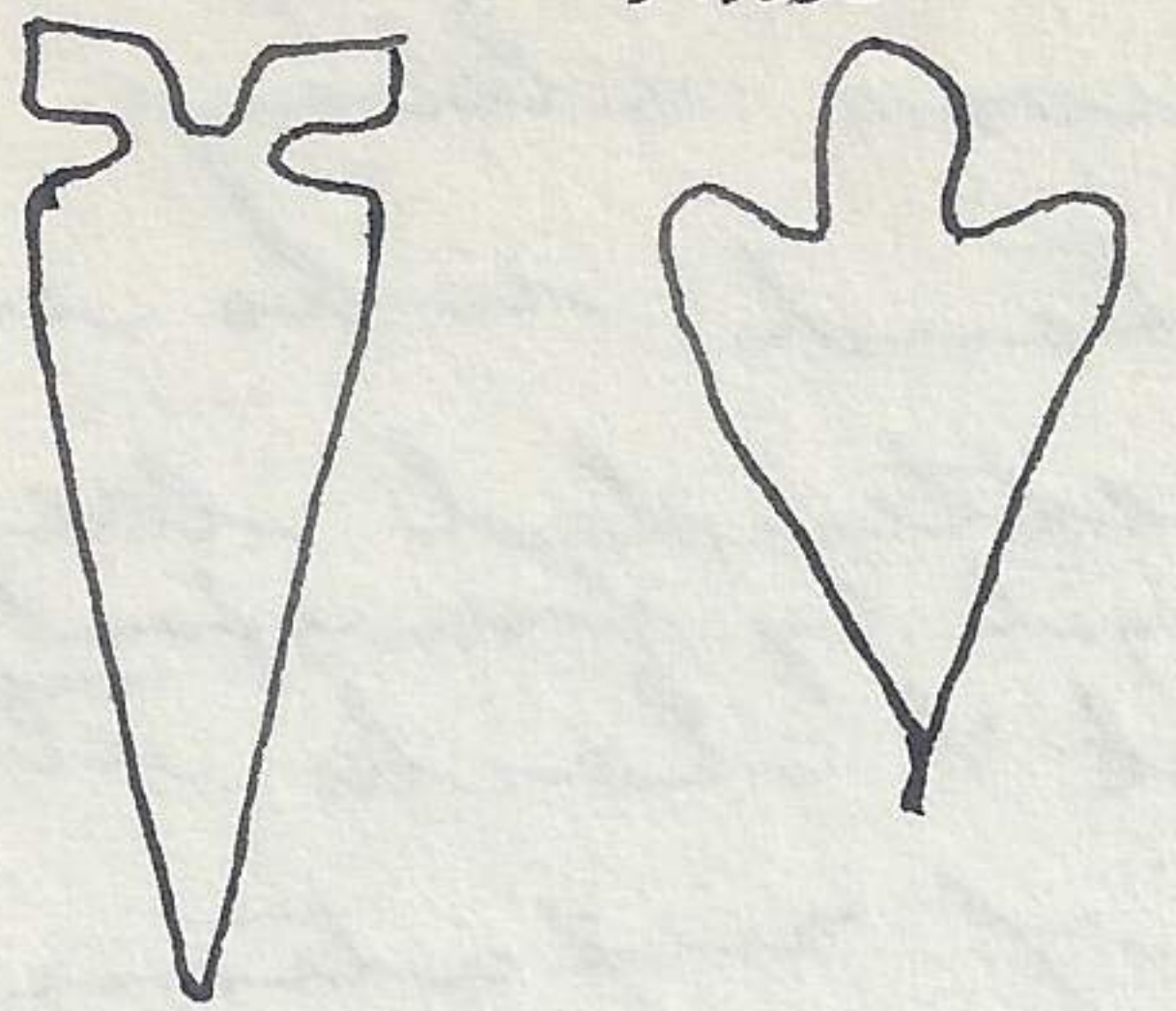

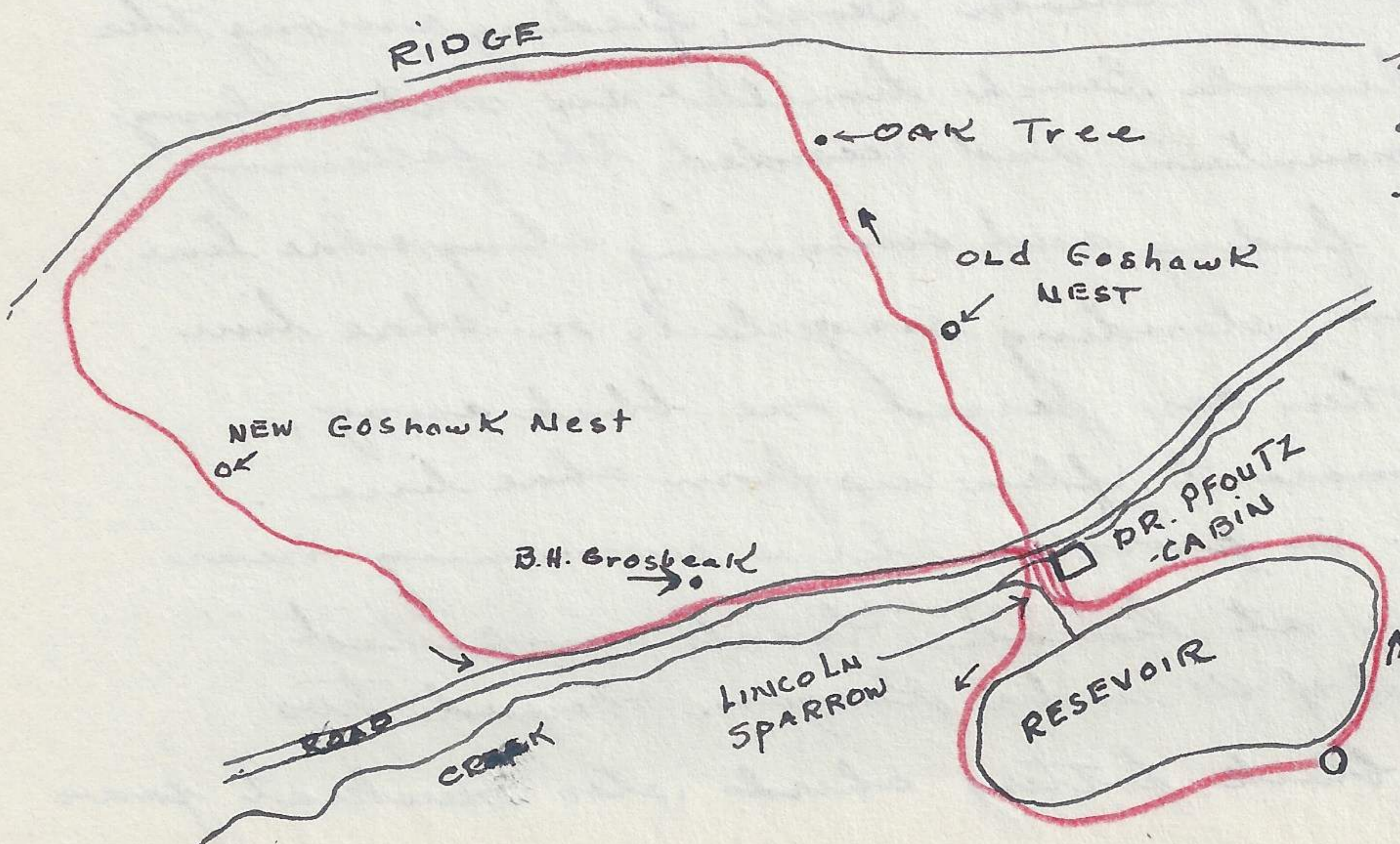


small bone fragments. Points of this collected petroglyph imprints from rocks on promontory. at sand knolls vicinity 100' from old lake shore bed about 2 miles below dunes. saw seven curlew feeding together in sage flat. The ground surface

in this area is hard and cracked from road to lake bed. At 6:00 P.M counted 12 nighthawks feeding 20' above ground in a measured mile course. Sixteen jacks were seen in area. On Indian knolls saw cottontail feeding in larger sages Chrysothamnus growth on knolls. The Lark Sparrows were the most common bird seen alongside of road from Lincoln Beach to Indian Sand Knolls, particularly common on west side of West Mountain. at Lincoln Beach a Rufous leg passed on boulder near road. a Raven followed me and I while working down the promontory point from the Provo Level. It circled and cawed frequently for 4 minutes keeping about 55' over head at all times. Light on rock at 40'. The four petroglyphs collected were; mt sheep from ledge 20' below ^{uppermost} cave and was associated with another irregular shaped one. Eagle (?) from flat rock on Provo Level below cave. Snake (?) 4 blocks north of cave on flat rock on Provo level. mt. Sheep Provo level below cave.
