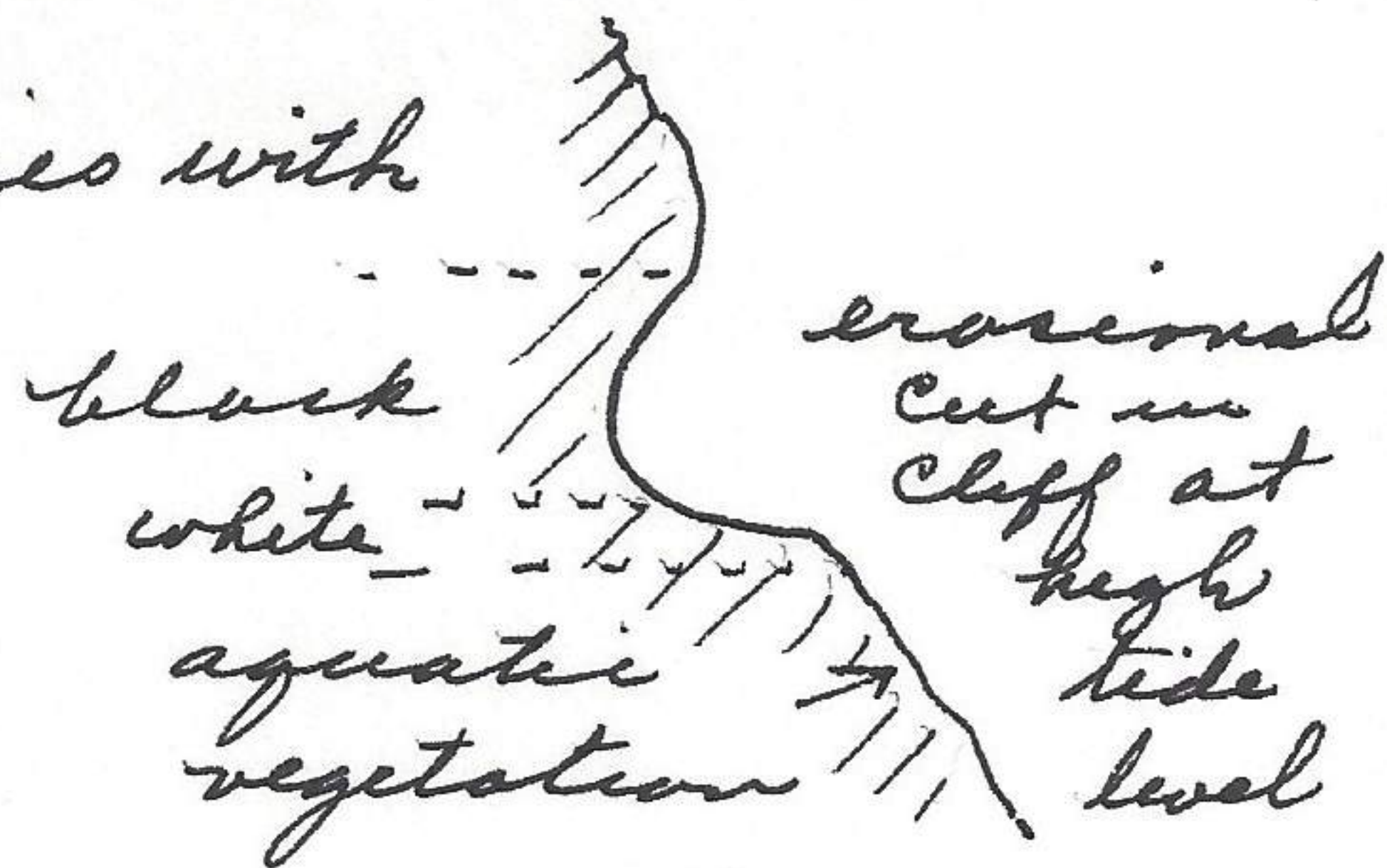


Bee Estate, Humphrey Head, Lopez Island, San Juan Co., Washington

May 24, 1986

Enroute to Anacortes noticed several ^{rock} shorelines with erosion of cliff at high tide.



May 25, 1986

May 26, 1986

To Chris and Steves. All to festival.

May 27, 1986

Left Chris' for Lopez. Enroute stopped Alewatts (white cabinet, ^{2 sides} and specimen cabinet still at Bruins.

At Anacortes Ferry Terminal observed: 2 band-tailed pigeons, 1 rufous hummingbird, ³ Cedar waxwing, ⁶ white-crowned sparrow, 1 American robin, ⁸ American Crow, ²⁰ barn swallow, ¹⁸ glaucous-winged gull.

at 14/10 mi N and 9/10 mi. E Lopez Village (P.O) not 8 deer in open field. Have seen them in this same area on several other occasions.

At 1916 School House noted 19 American Crows in pasture to S in one group.

May 28, 1986

no birds in sound between Bee House and Leo Reef.

10:00 A.M. 2 marbled murrelets 200' SE Bee House.

10:35 A.M. 2 otters swim past Bee House going S. 15' out from shore. These were the first since previously recorded in journal.

10:40 3 mule deer (black-tailed subsp.) at feeder. After 10' feeding went up trail to Deer Trail slope and remained in area for 45 min.

no humming birds so far nor has seagull level changed since yesterday.

Four pine siskin, 1 purple finch, 3 house finch, 3 eastern gray squirrels, 3 T. chipmunks and 4 brown-headed cowbirds at porch feeder. The numbers are considerably less than one week ago.
